## REPORT OF DEGREES AWARDED

This report covers one fiscal year and includes all degrees awarded in the period of July 1, 1980, to June 30, 1981. Thus, the 1980-81 figures include the degrees awarded Summer 1980, Fall 1980, and Spring 1981. The statistics by degree program commencing on Page 4 are tabulated by the August, December, and June commencements. You will notice this is a slight change from previous years' reports which included August and June commencements only. Last Fall 1980 was the first term in which CSU held a fall commencement ceremony to award degrees earned during the fall semester. Previously all fall degrees were tabulated with the spring commencement degrees awarded.

The total of 3,984 degrees awarded in 1980-81 is an increase of 175, or 4.6 percent, over the 1979-80 total of 3,809 which, until this year, was the largest number of degrees ever awarded for a full fiscal year at CSU. The 3,984 degrees awarded include 2,939 bachelor's degrees, 749 master's degrees, 161 doctor's degrees, and 135 doctor of veterinary medicine degrees.

Since the first bachelor's degrees were awarded in 1884, a total of 56,744 have been awarded. The first master's degree was awarded in 1893 and 12,818 have been awarded to date. Since 1904, 3,149 doctor of veterinary medicine degrees have been awarded, and since the first in 1955, 2,115 doctor's degrees have been awarded.

Men received 56.9 percent of the degrees this year, compared to 56.2 percent last year; and women received 43.1 percent, compared to 43.8 percent a year ago.
