## REPORT OF DEGREES AWARDED

This report covers one fiscal year and includes all degrees awarded in the period of July 1, 1981, to June 30, 1982. Thus, the 1981-82 figures include the degrees awarded Summer 1981, Fall 1981, and Spring 1982. The statistics by degree program commencing on Page 4 are tabulated by the August, December, and June commencements.

The total of 3975 degrees awarded in 1981-82 is a decrease of 9, or 0.2 percent, over the 1980-81 total of 3984 which was the largest number of degrees ever awarded for a full fiscal year at CSU. The 3975 degrees awarded include 2990 bachelor's degrees, 697 master's degrees, 156 doctor's degrees, and 132 doctor of veterinary medicine degrees.

Since the first bachelor's degrees were awarded in 1884, a total of 59,734 have been awarded. The first master's degree was awarded in 1893 and 13,515 have been awarded to date. Since 1904, 3305 doctor of veterinary medicine degrees have been awarded, and since the first in 1955, 2247 doctor's degrees have been awarded.

Men received 54.7 percent of the degrees this year, compared to 56.9 percent last year; and women received 45.3 percent, compared to 43.1 percent a year ago.

Five colleges awarded a higher number of degrees this year than last, with the largest increases occurring in the College of Natural Sciences and the College of Professional Studies. However, the large increase in bachelor's degrees awarded in Professional Studies and the entire decrease in bachelor's degrees awarded in Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences can be accounted for by the department of social work changing from Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences to Professional Studies. This year saw decreases in all types of degrees awarded over last year with the exception of a small increase in bachelor's degrees awarded.
