REPORT OF DEGREES AWARDED

This report covers one fiscal year and includes all degrees awarded in the period of July 1, 1982, to June 30, 1983. Thus, the 1982-83 figures include the degrees awarded Summer 1982, Fall 1982, and Spring 1983. The statistics by degree program commencing on Page 4 are tabulated by the August, December, and June commencements.

The total of 4,013 degrees awarded in 1982-83 is an increase of 38, or 1.0 percent, over the 1981-82 total of 3,975. The 1982-83 total is the largest number of degrees ever awarded for a full fiscal year at CSU. The 4,013 degrees include 2,979 bachelor's degrees, 740 master's degrees, 159 doctor's degrees, and 135 doctor of veterinary medicine degrees.

Since the first bachelor's degrees were presented in 1884, a total of 62,713 have been awarded. The first master's degree was given in 1893 and 14,255 have been awarded to date. Since 1904, 3,440 doctor of veterinary medicine degrees have been awarded, and since the first in 1955, 2,406 doctor's degrees have been presented.

Men received 54.0 percent of the degrees this year, compared to 54.7 percent last year; and women received 46.0 percent, compared to 45.3 percent a year ago.

Four colleges awarded a higher number of degrees this year than last. The College of Business had the largest increase in the total number of degrees awarded. For bachelor's degrees, the College of Business and the College of Professional Studies showed the largest gains. At the master's level, the greatest increases were in the College of Business and the College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences. The College of Engineering experienced the largest increase in the number of Doctor of Philosophy degrees.
