This report covers one fiscal year and includes all degrees awarded in the period of July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986. Thus, the 1985-86 figures include the degrees awarded Summer Session 1985, Fall Semester 1985, and Spring Semester 1986. The statistics by degree program commencing on Page 4 are tabulated by semester.

The total of 3,945 degrees awarded in 1985-86 is an increase of 148, or 3.9 percent, over the 1984-85 total of 3,797. The 3,945 degrees include 2,964 bachelor's degrees, 698 master's degrees, 152 doctor's degrees, and 131 doctor of veterinary medicine degrees.

Since the first bachelor's degrees were presented in 1884, a total of 71,379 have been awarded. The first master's degree was given in 1893 and 16,344 have been awarded to date. Since 1904, 3,840 doctor of veterinary medicine degrees have been awarded, and since the first in 1955, 2,877 doctor's degrees have been presented.

Men received 53.2 percent of the degrees this year, compared to 52.2 percent last year; and women received 46.8 percent, compared to 47.8 percent a year ago.

Five colleges awarded more total degrees in the 1985-86 fiscal year than in the previous year. These colleges are Agricultural Sciences, Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences, Engineering, Human Resource Sciences, and Natural Sciences. These same colleges and the College of Professional Sciences showed increases for bachelor's degrees. At the master's level, the College of Engineering experienced the greatest increase, while the Colleges of Business, Human Resource Sciences, Natural Sciences, and Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences also exhibited increases. The Colleges of Agricultural Sciences, Human Resource Sciences, and Natural Sciences showed increases in doctor of philosophy degrees.
