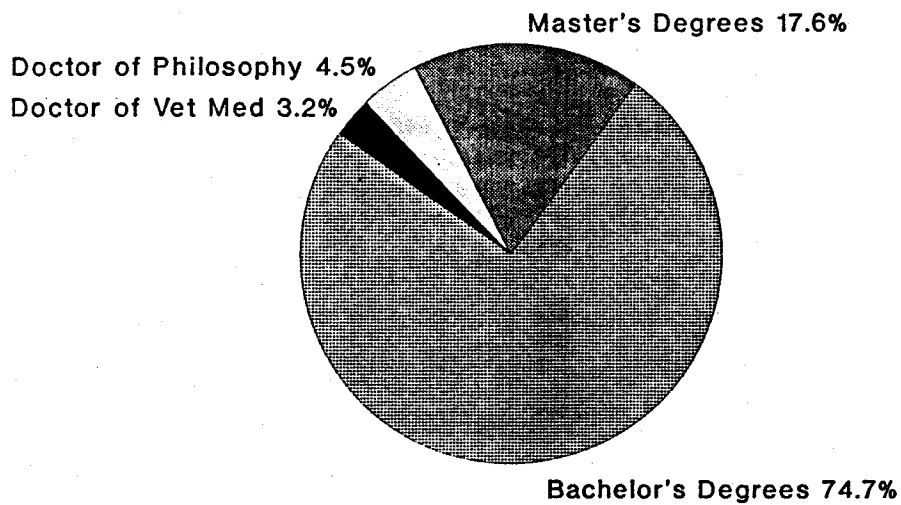

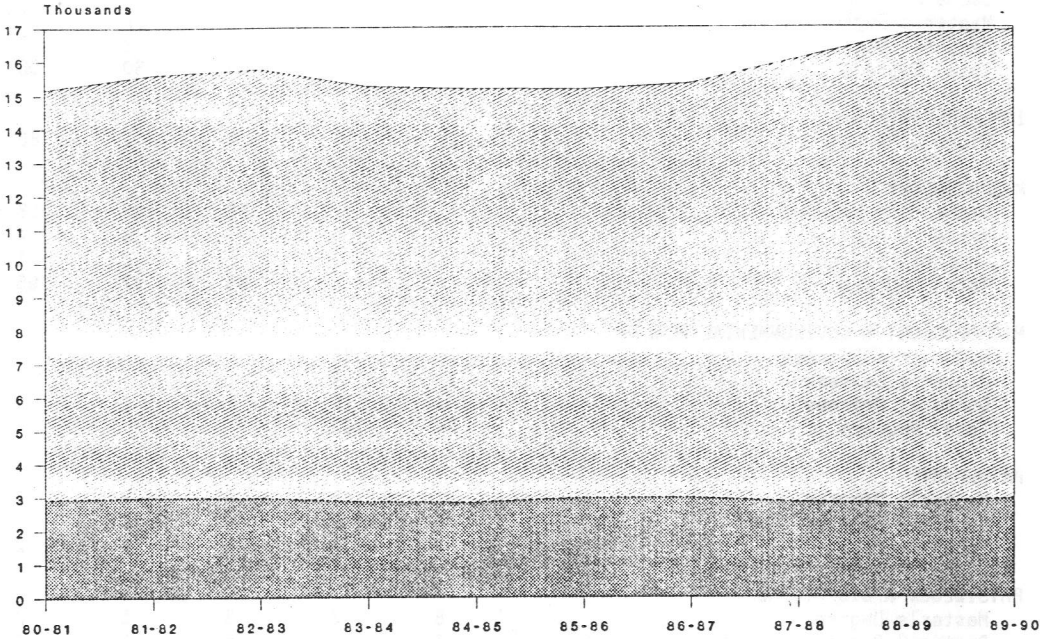

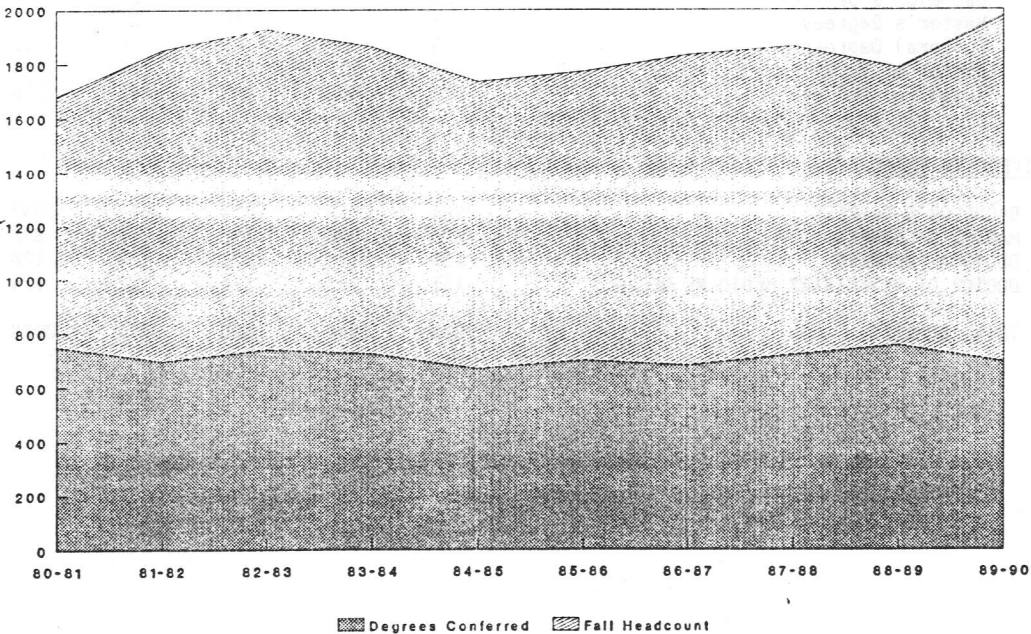

WITH BACHELOR'S DEGREES CONFERRED

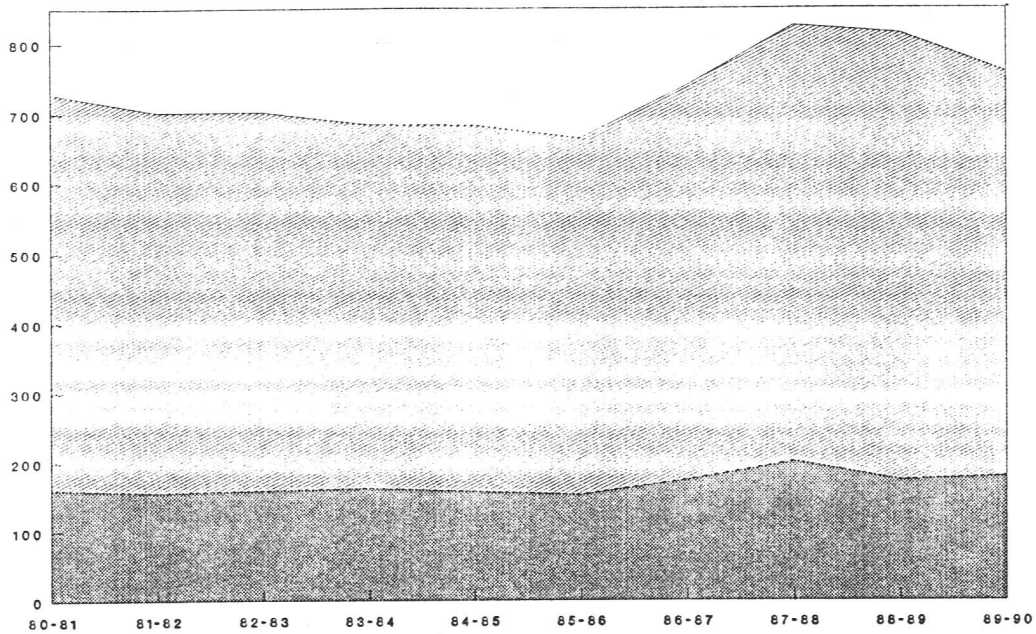


GRADUATE I ENROLLMENT  
WITH MASTER'S DEGREES CONFERRED

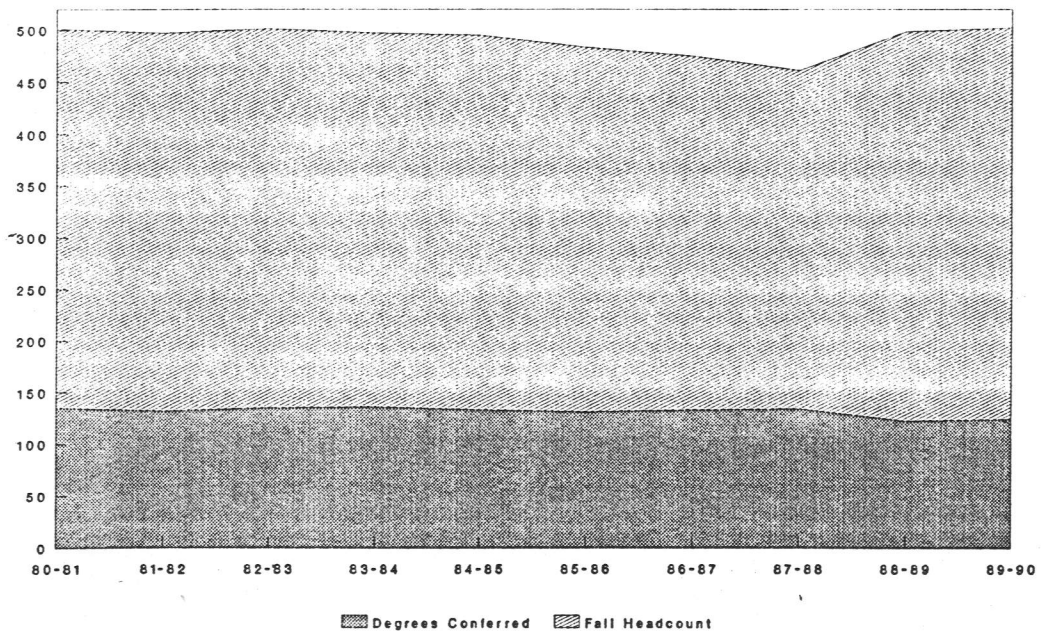


TEN-YEAR COMPARISON OF DEGREES CONFERRED VERSUS FALL HEADCOUNT
