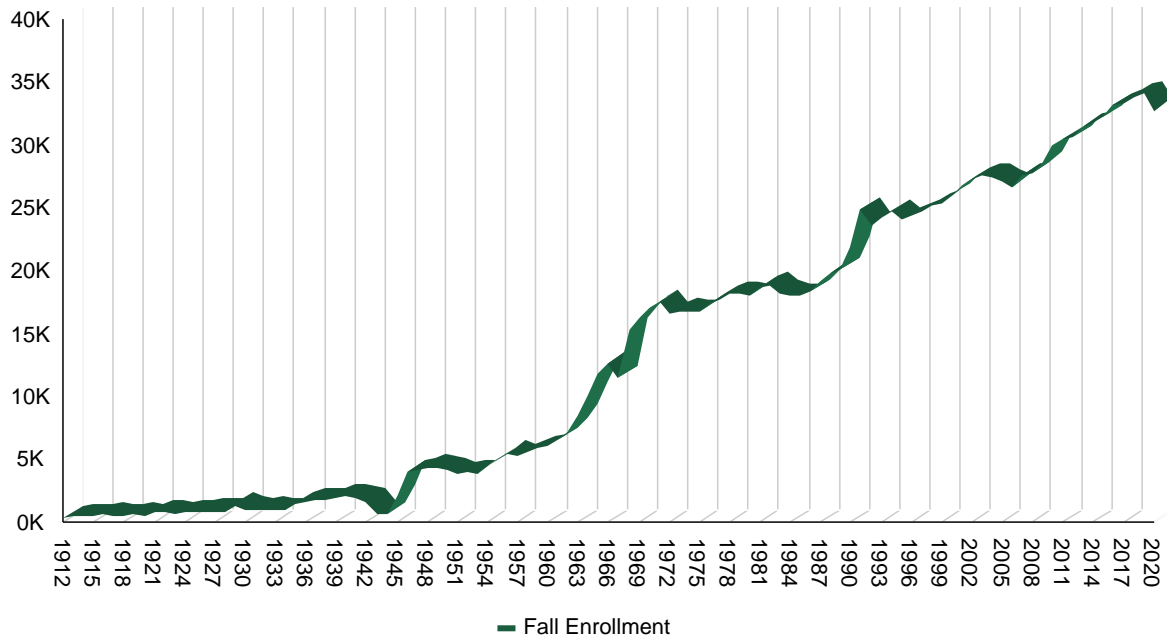

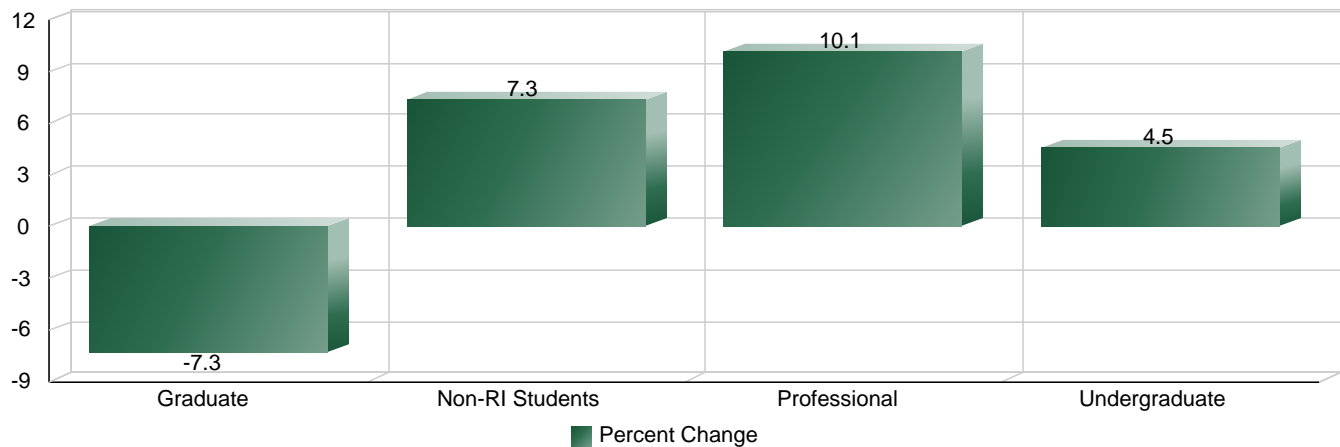

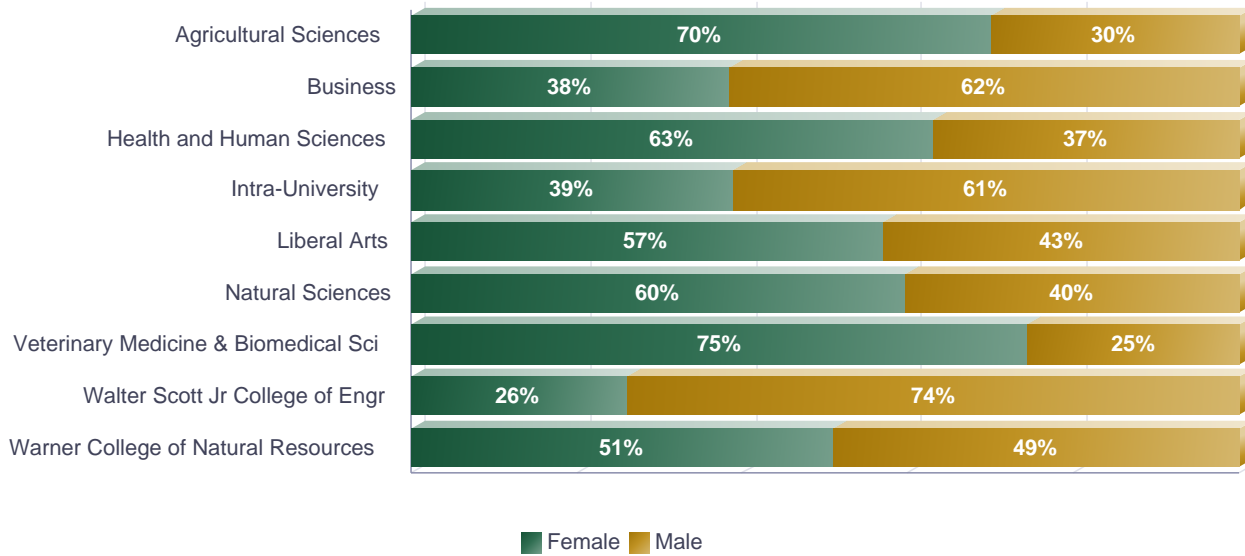

Fall 2020 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Gender - Percent of Students

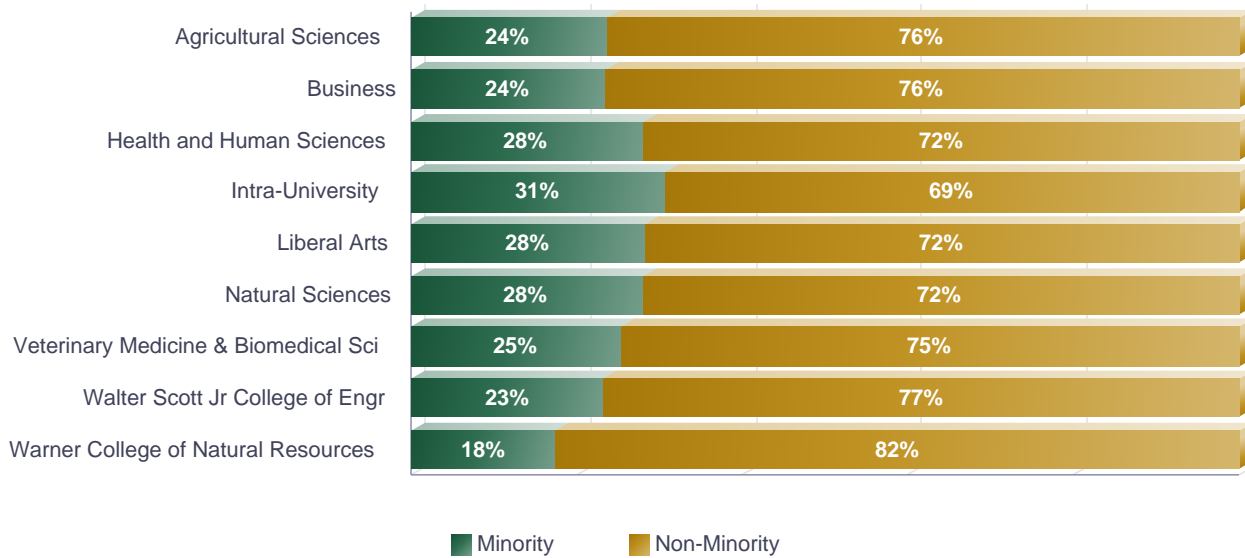

Fall 2020 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Minority Status - Percent of Students

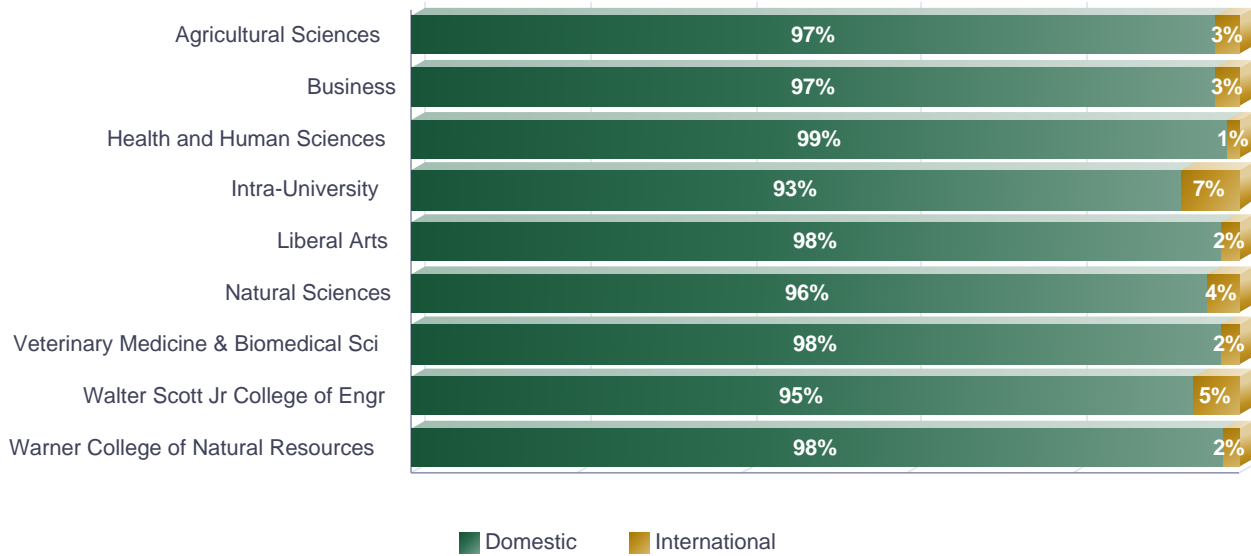

Fall 2020 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and International Status - Percent of Students

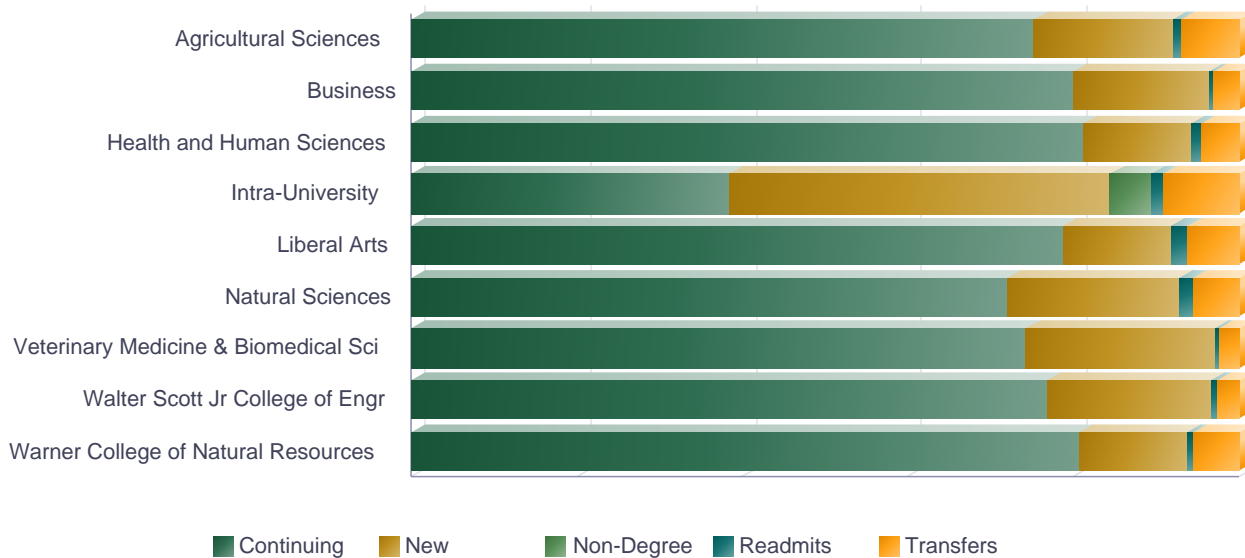

Fall 2020 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Registration Type - Percent of Students

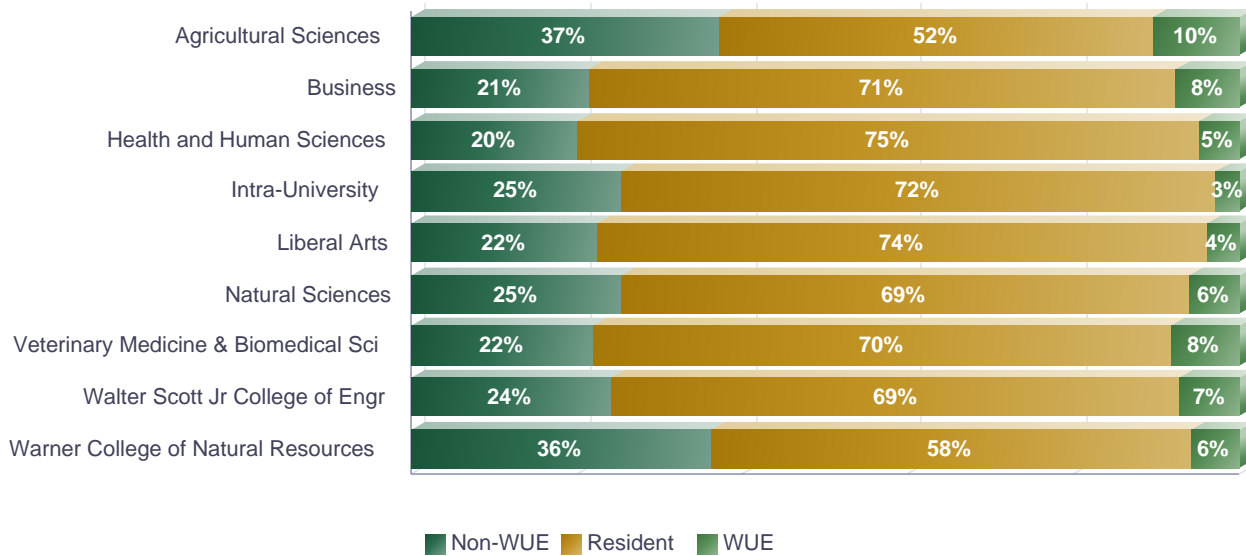

Fall 2020 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Residency - Percent of Students

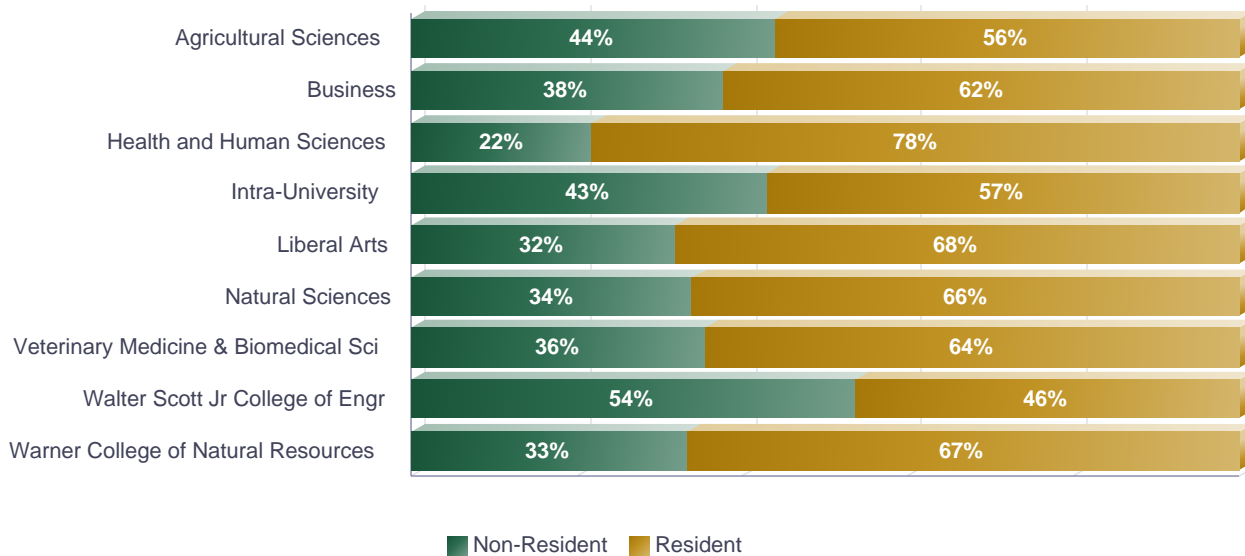

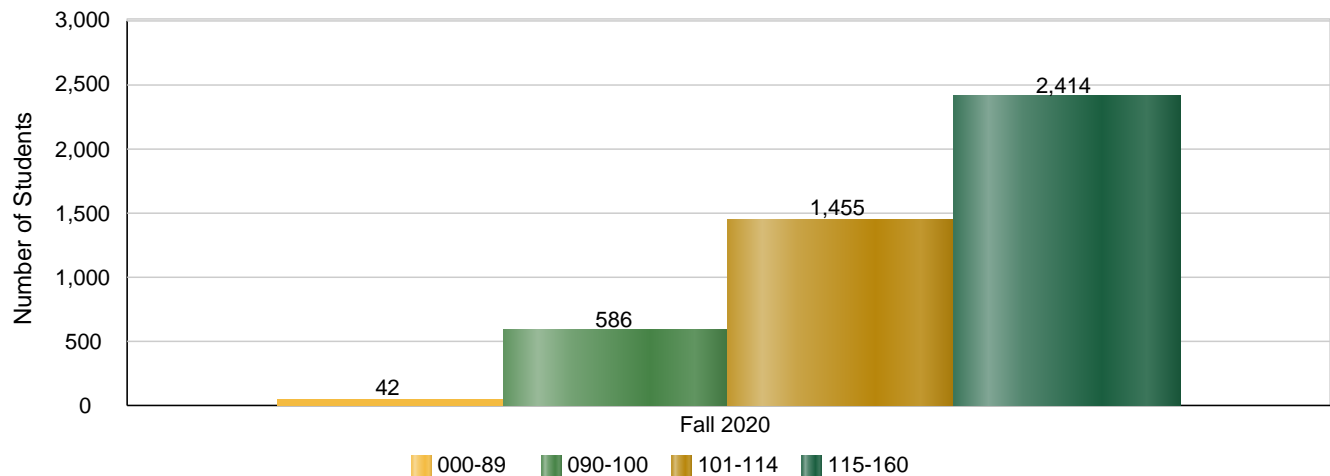

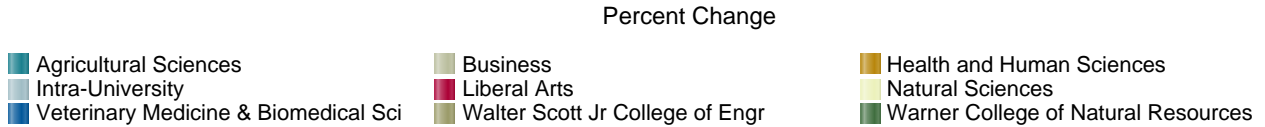
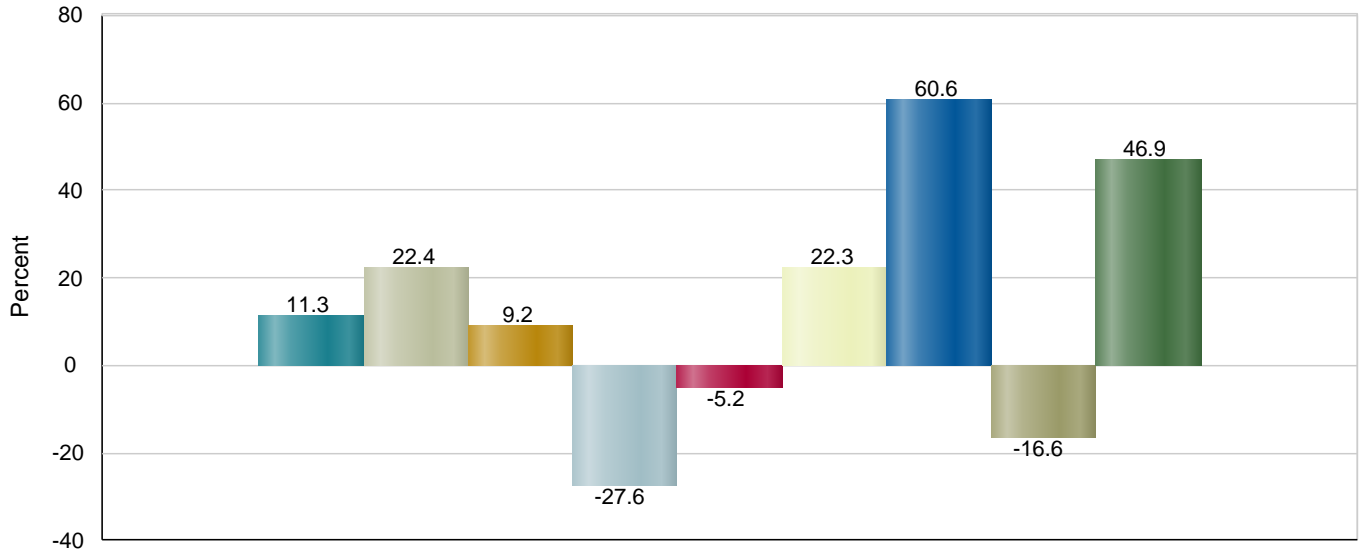
Fall 2020 CCHE Index Distribution

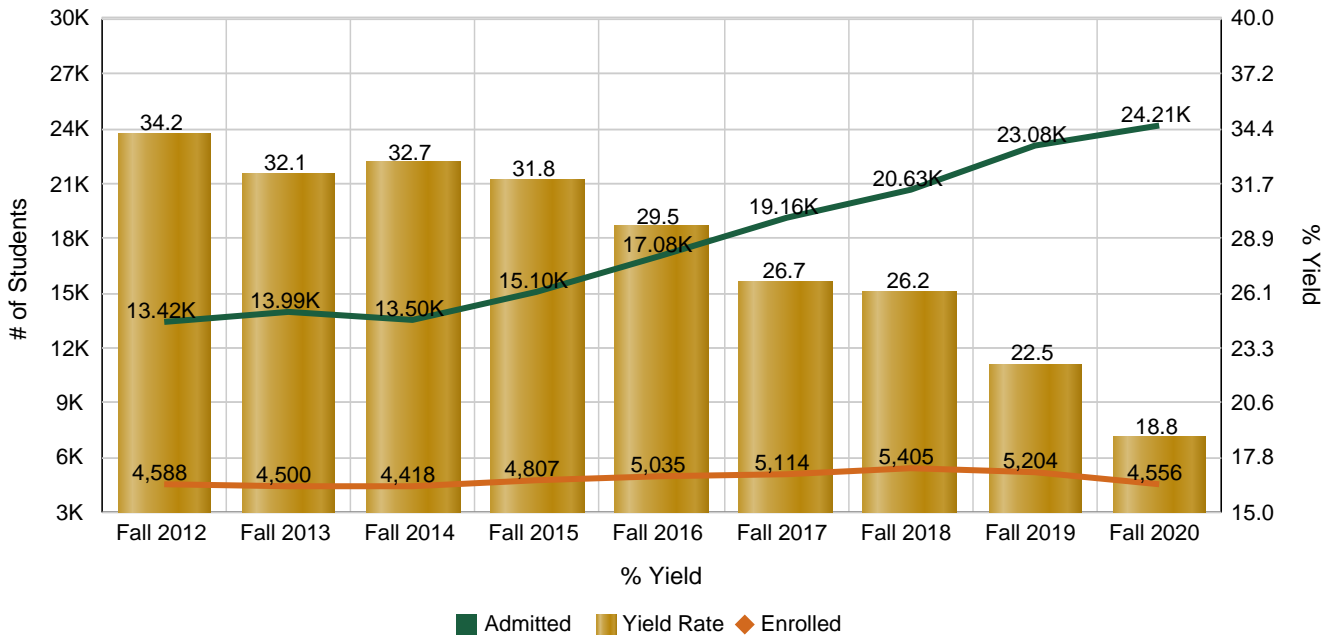

Fall 2012 to Fall 2020 Percent Change in New Freshman by Application College



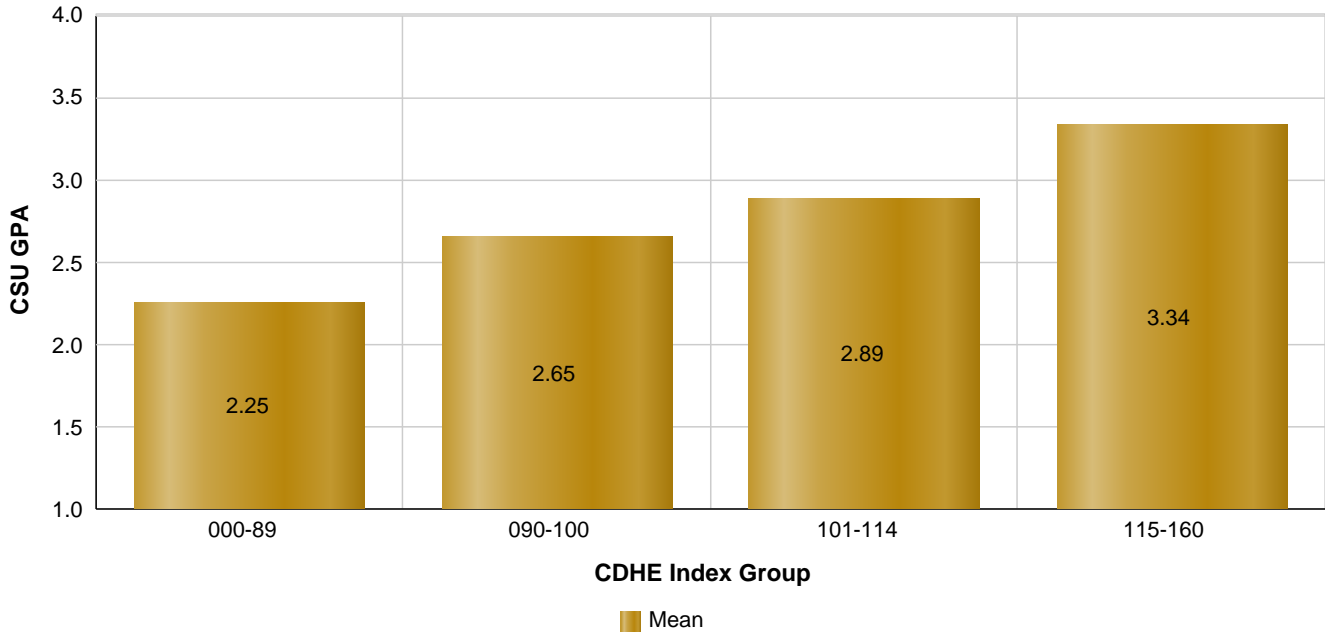

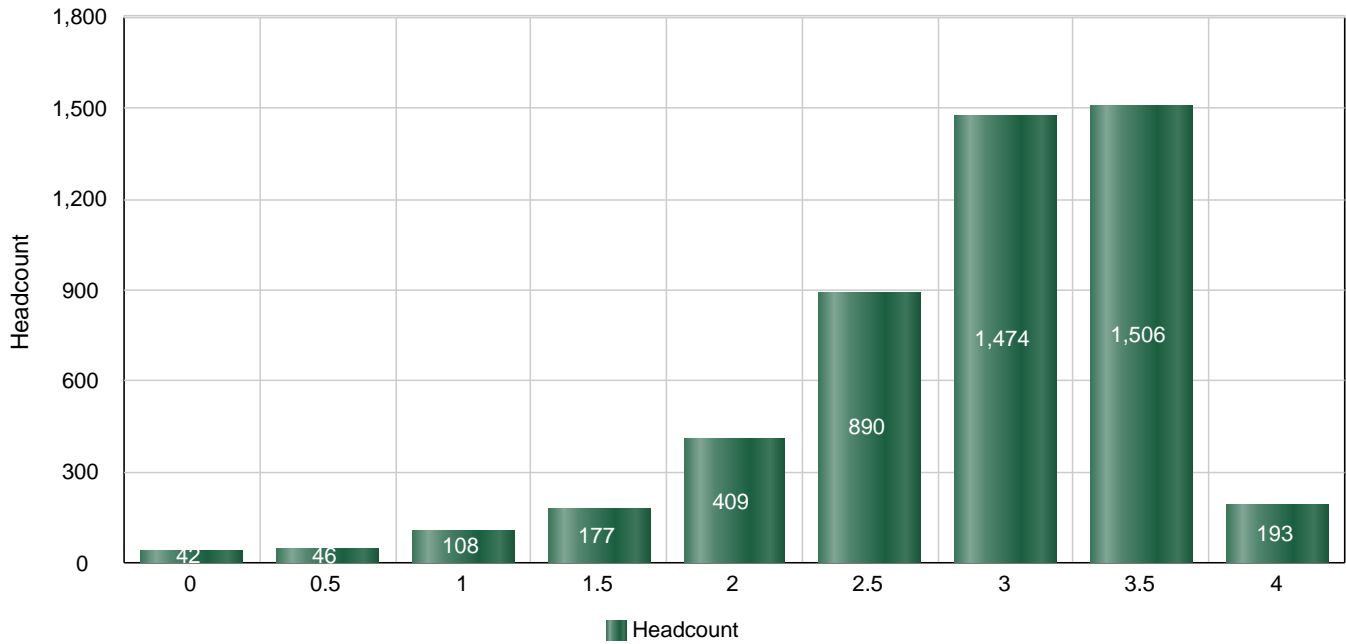


Fall Term New Freshman First-Year CSU Grade Point Average - Fall 2019 Entering Freshmen

First-Year CSU Grade Point Average and CDHE Index



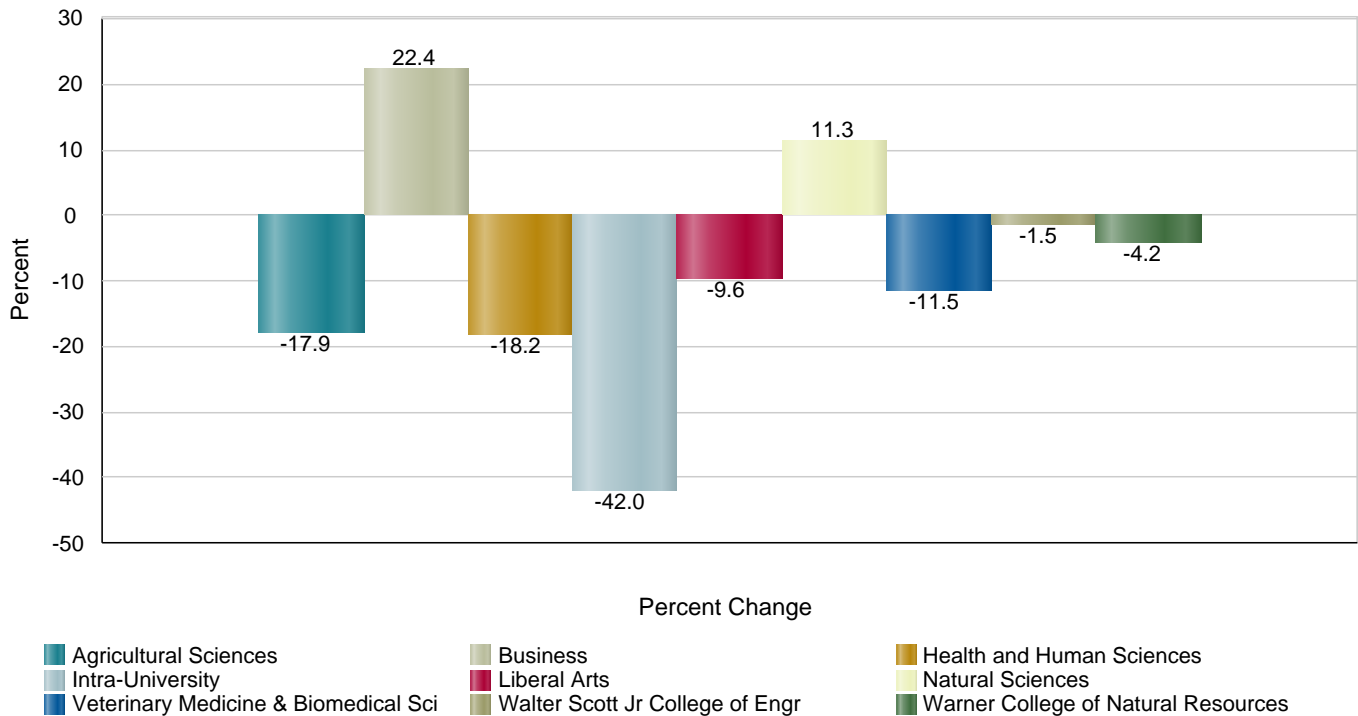
First-Year CSU GPA Distribution - Number of Students

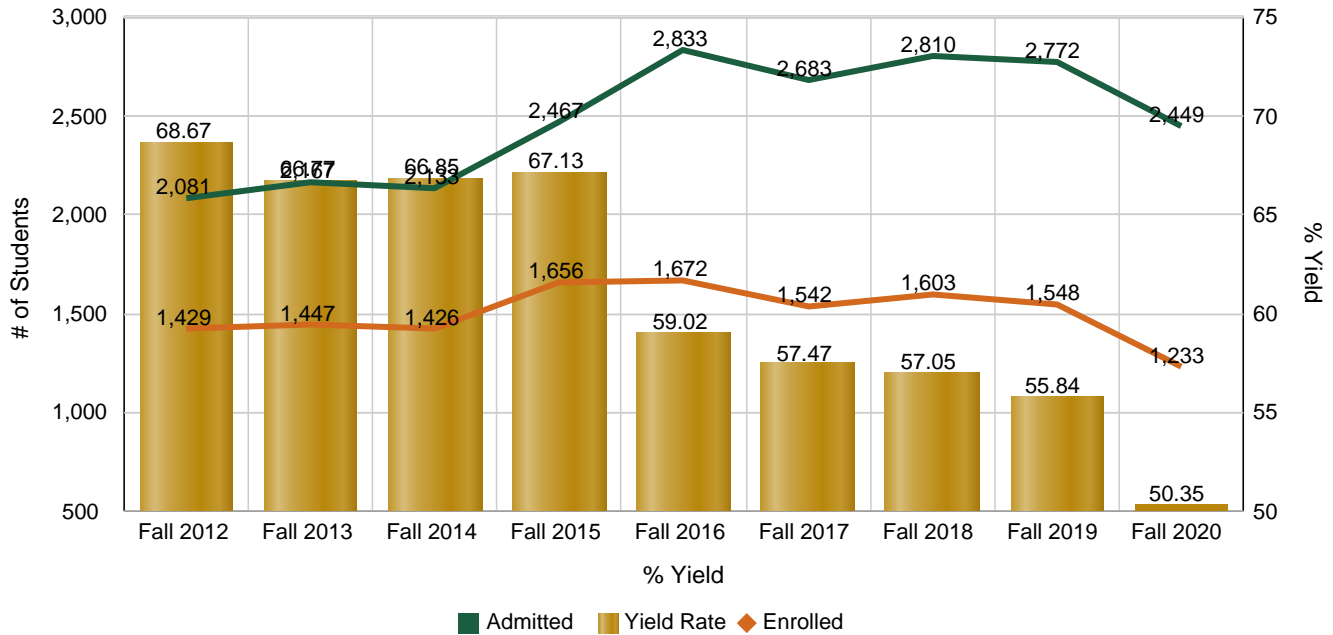

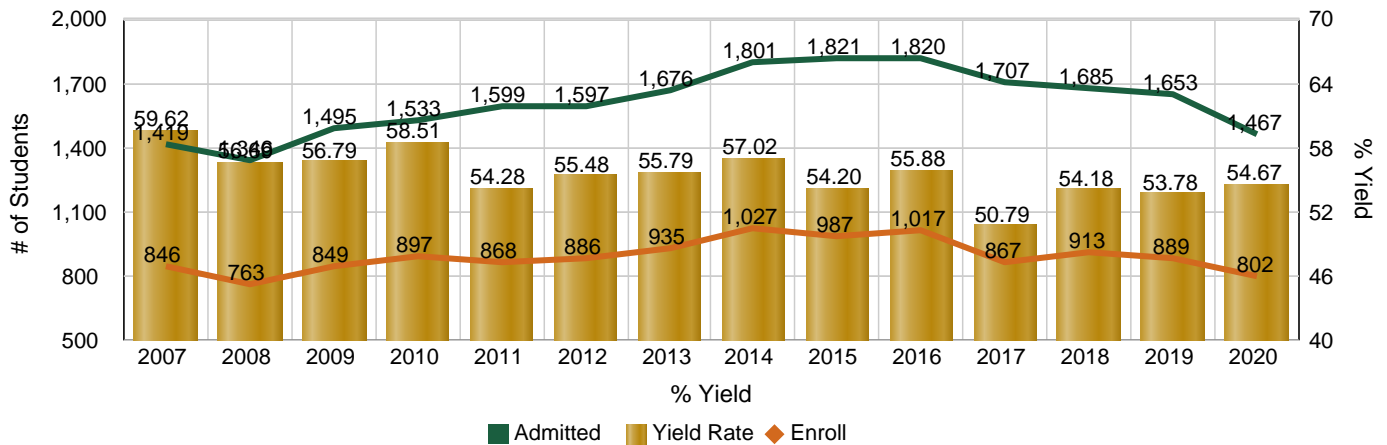

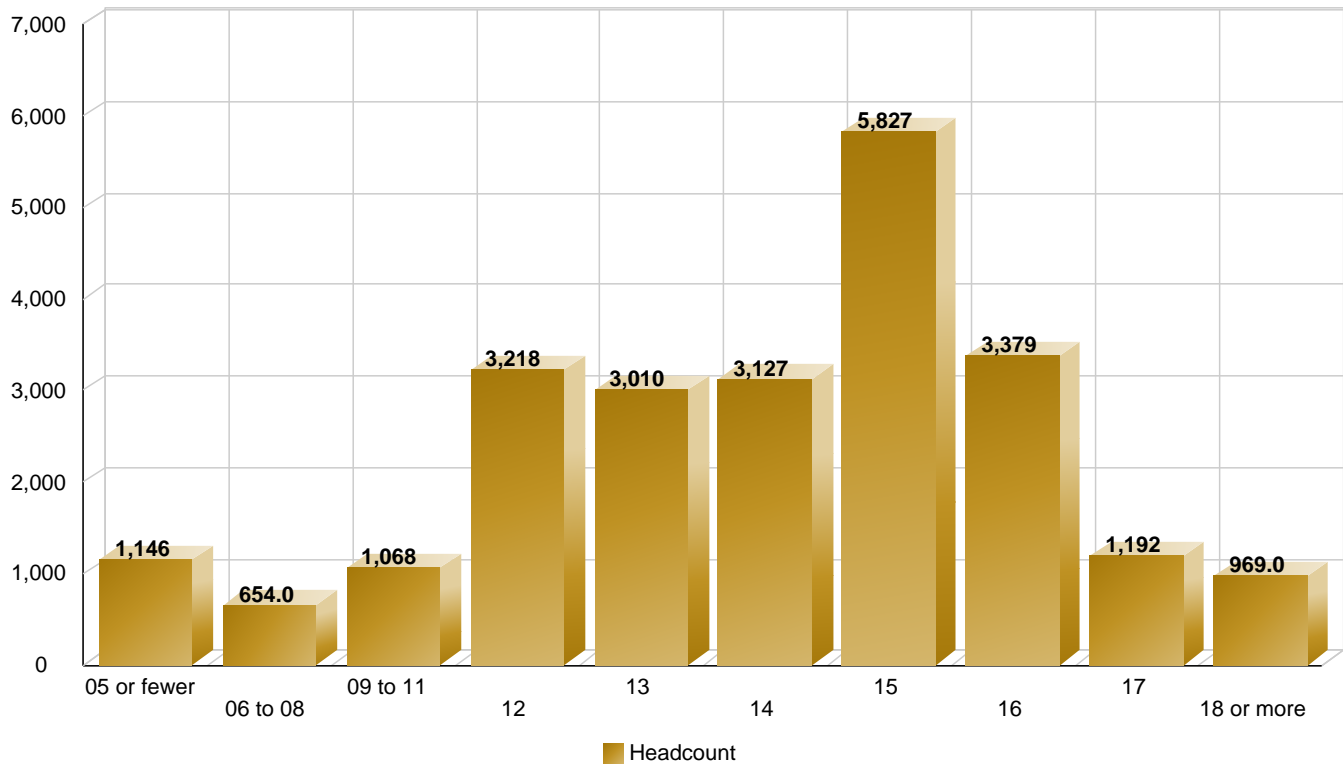

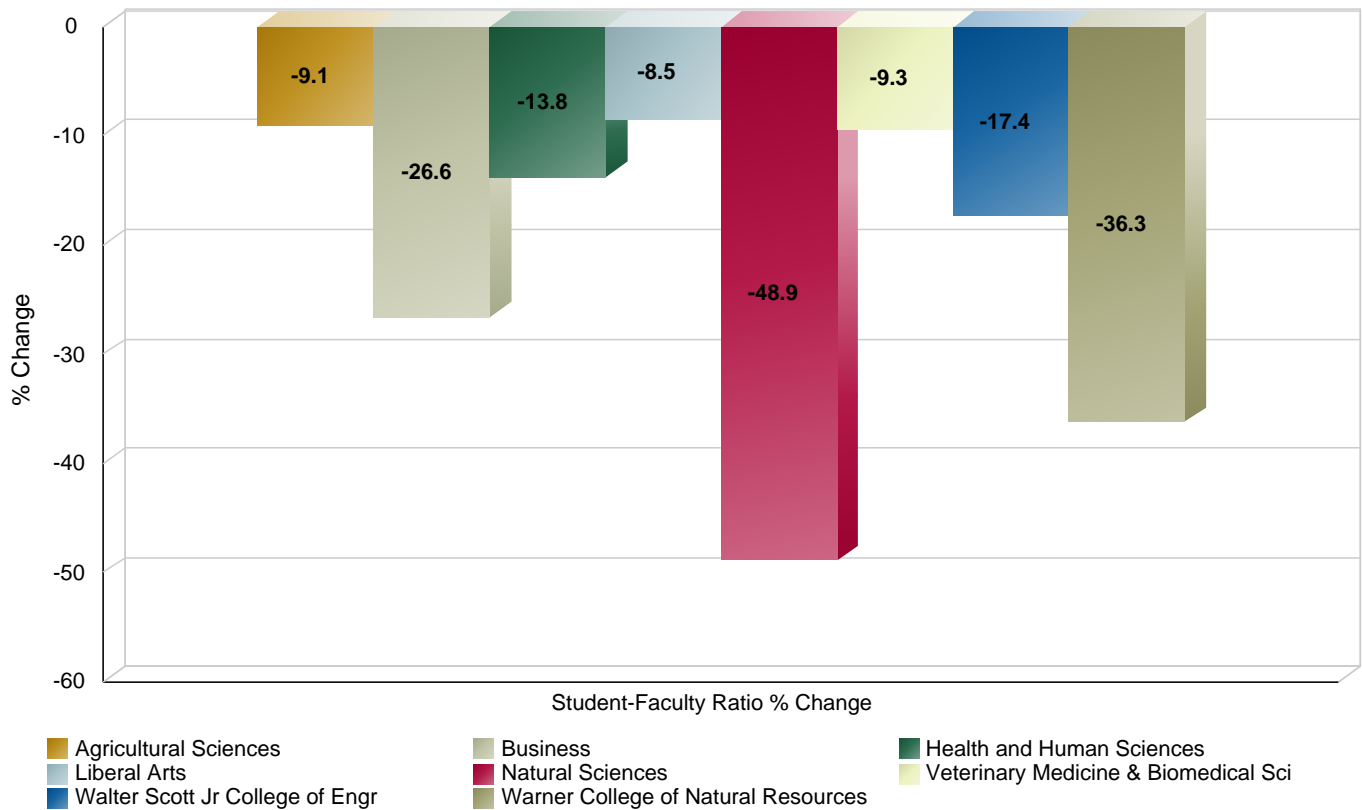
Fall 2020 Undergraduate Students by Credit Load

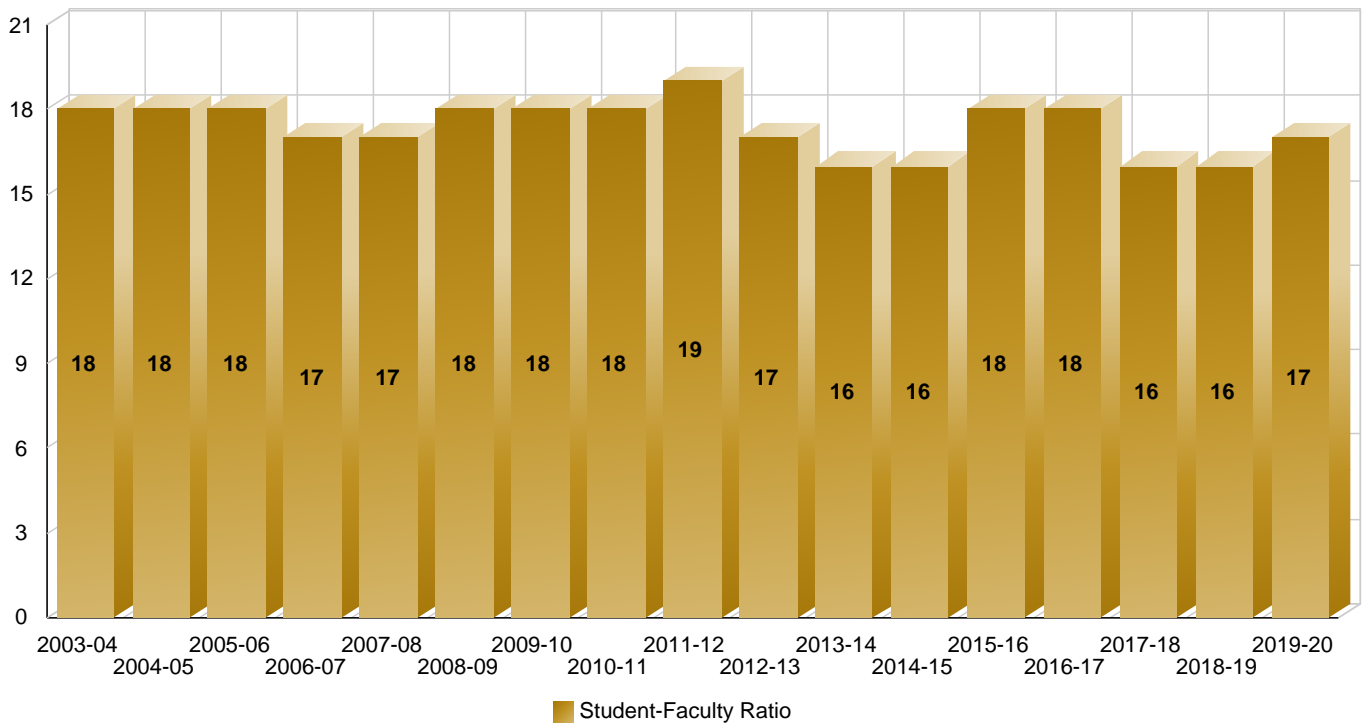

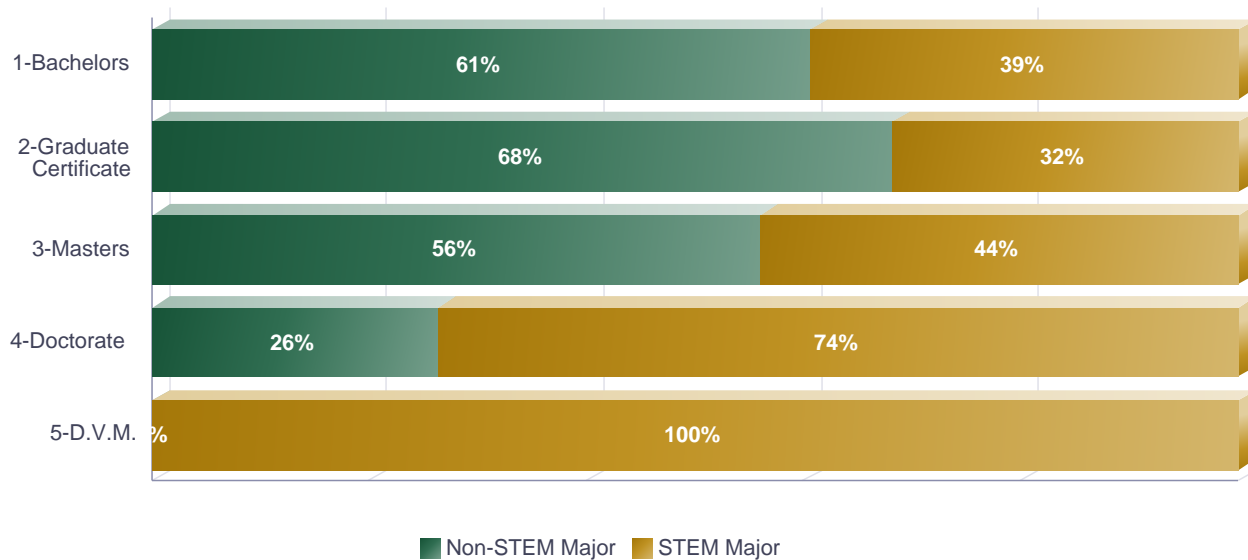

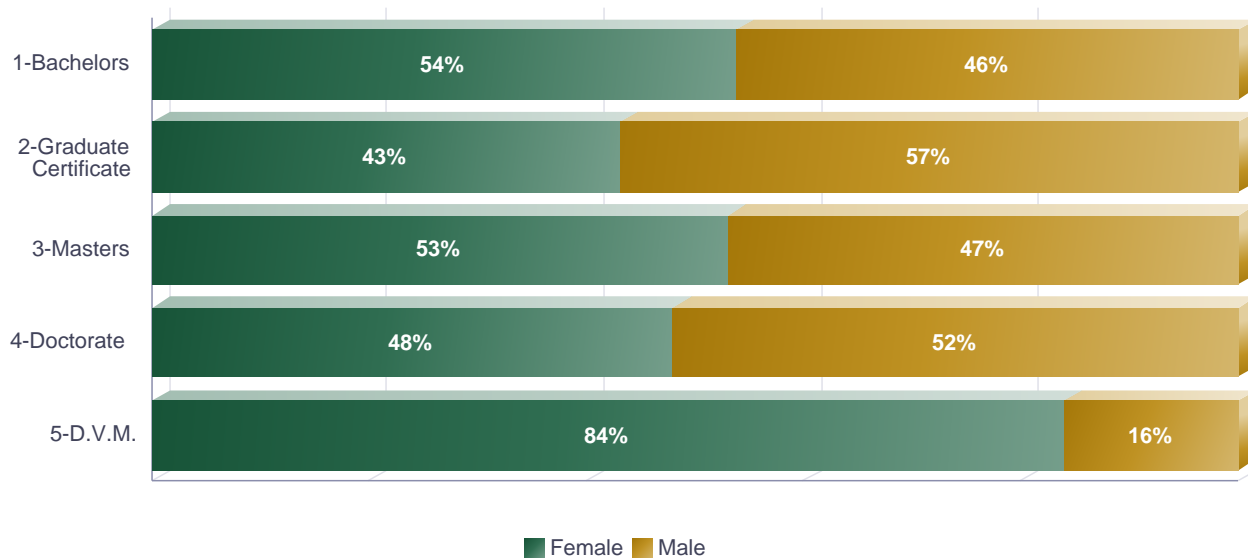
Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and STEM Status - Percent of Students

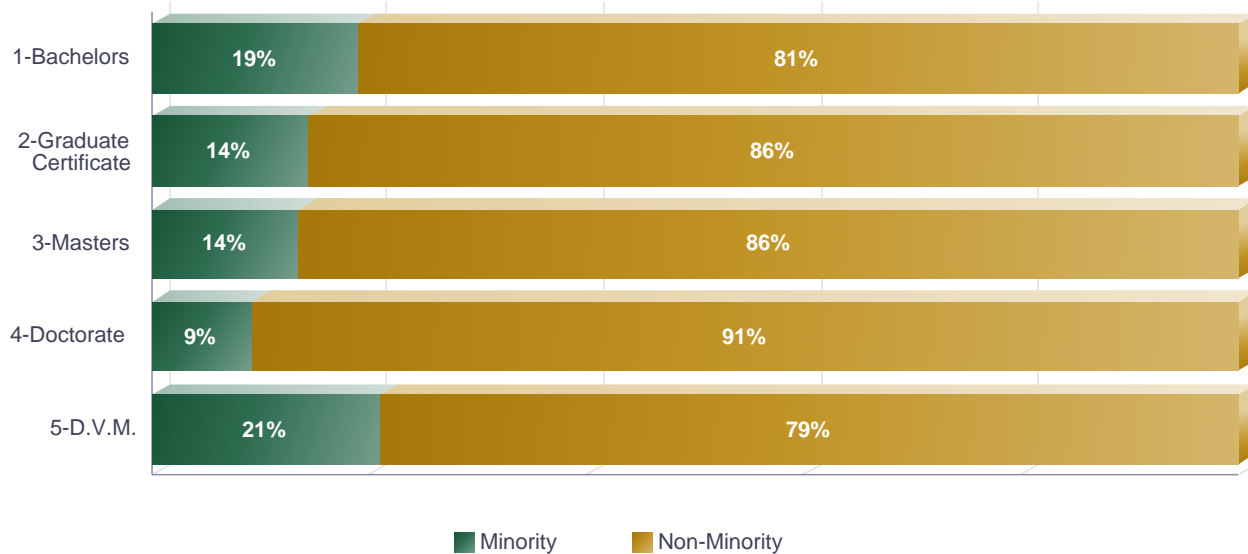
Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and Gender - Percent of Students

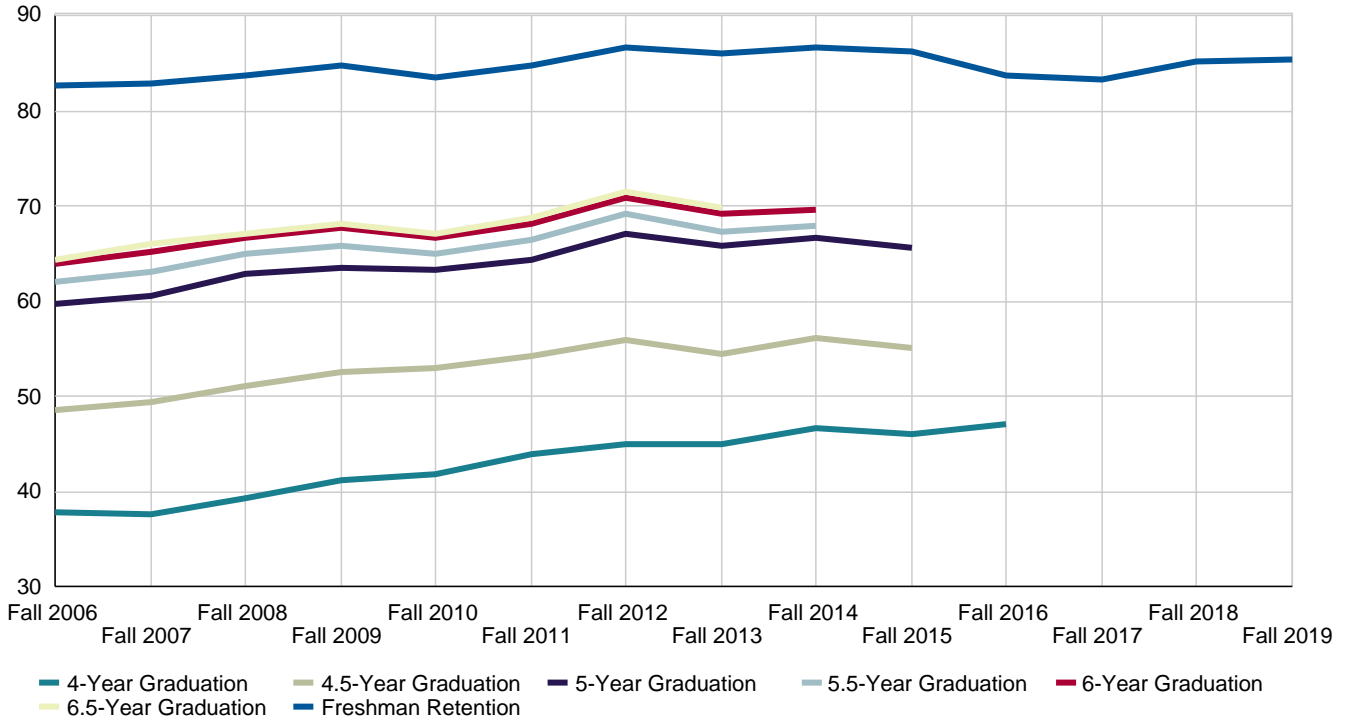

Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and Minority Status - Percent of Students

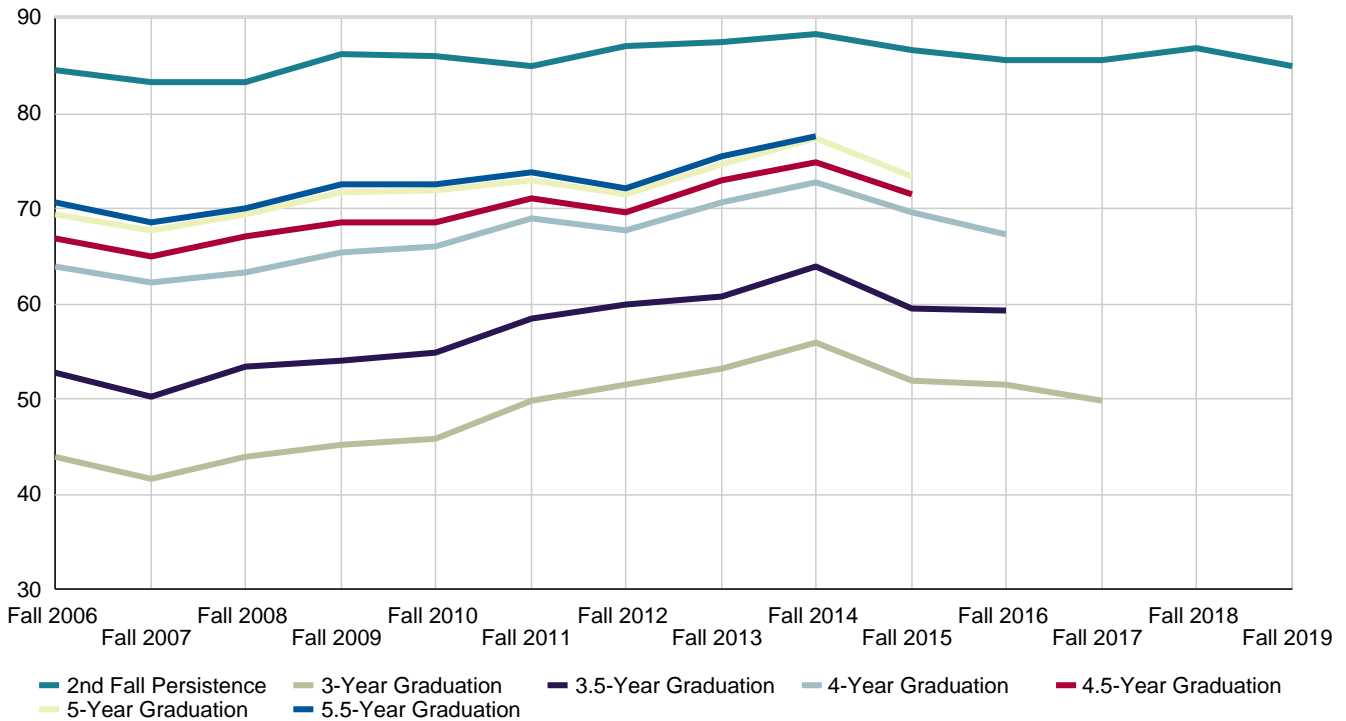

(includes summer starts)**



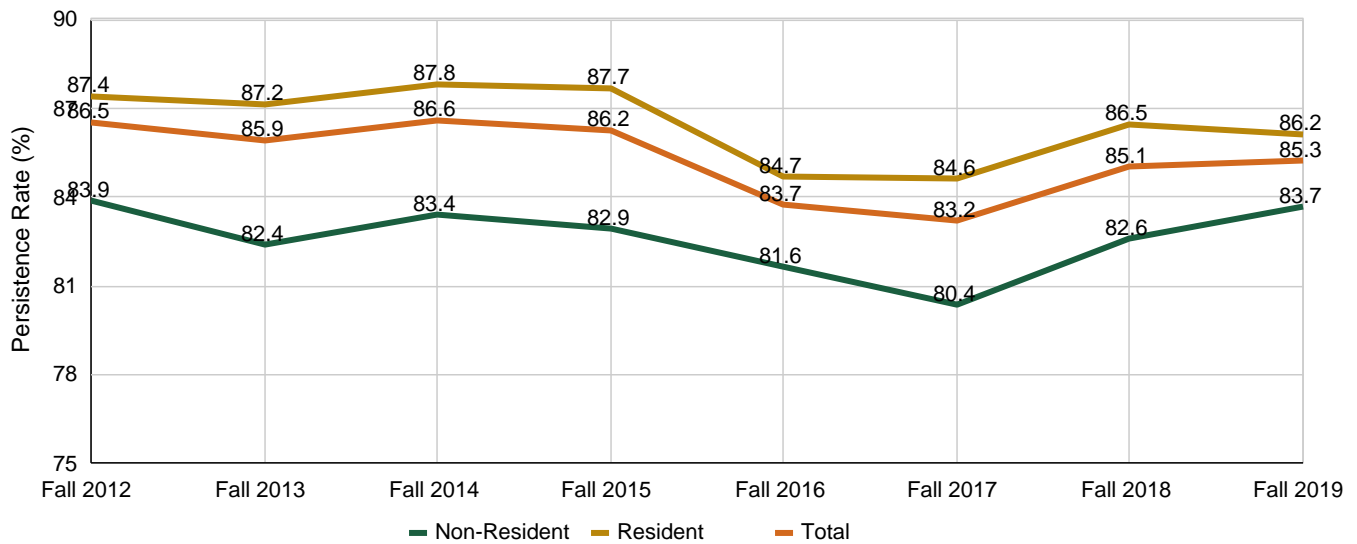
History of Transfer Students 2nd-Fall Persistence and Graduation Rates

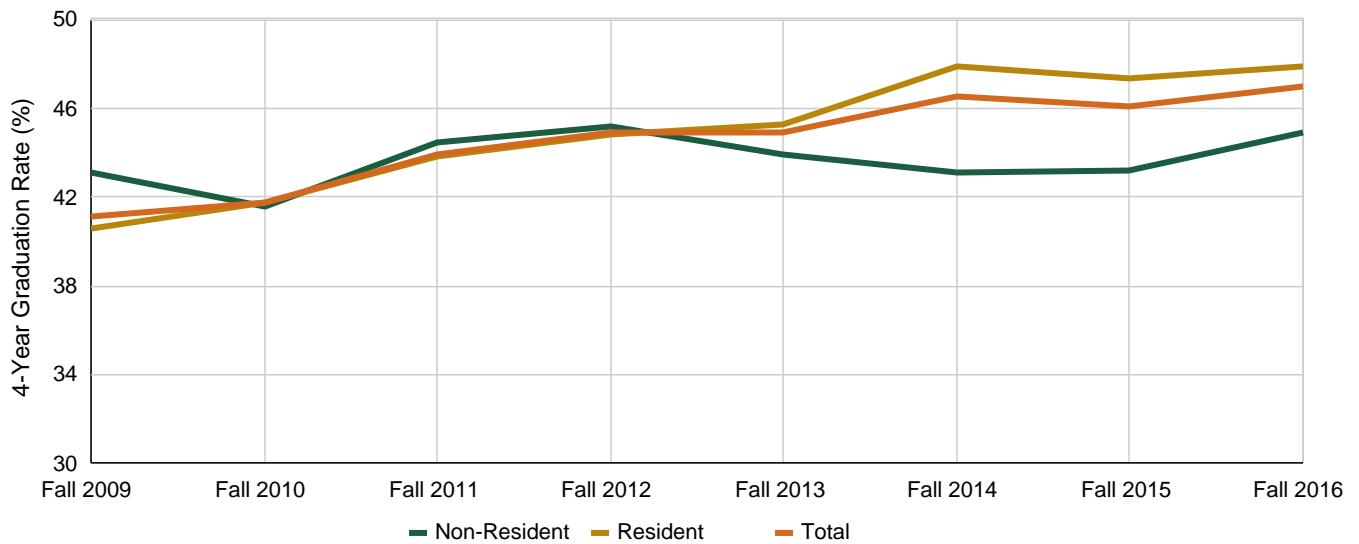
Freshman Retention by Residency - Comparison with Total

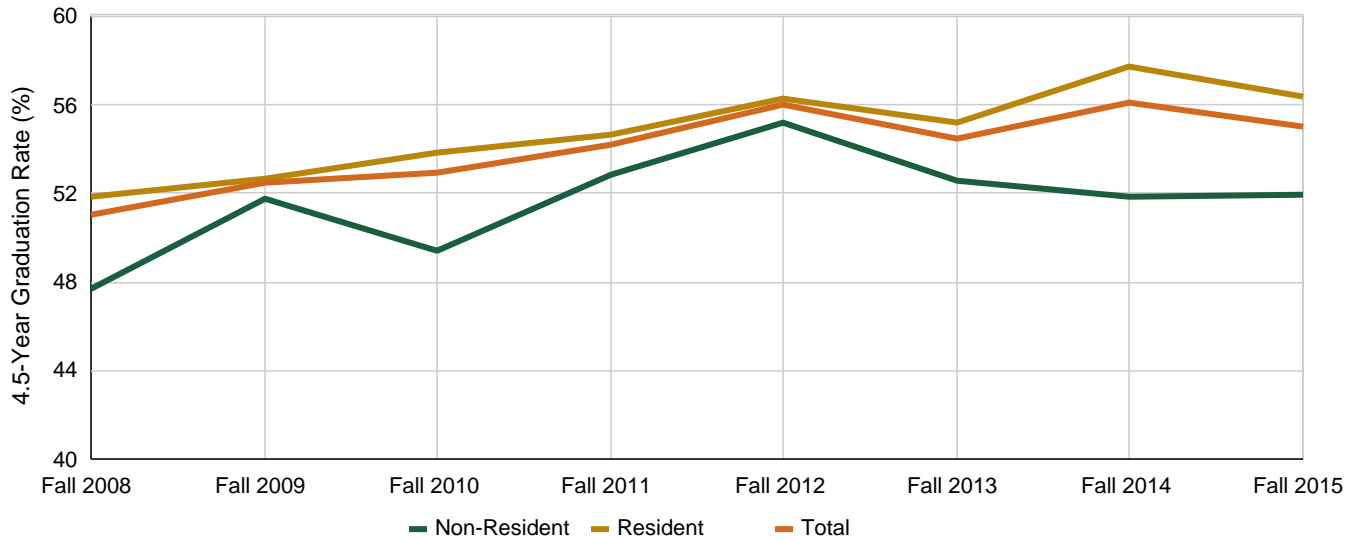

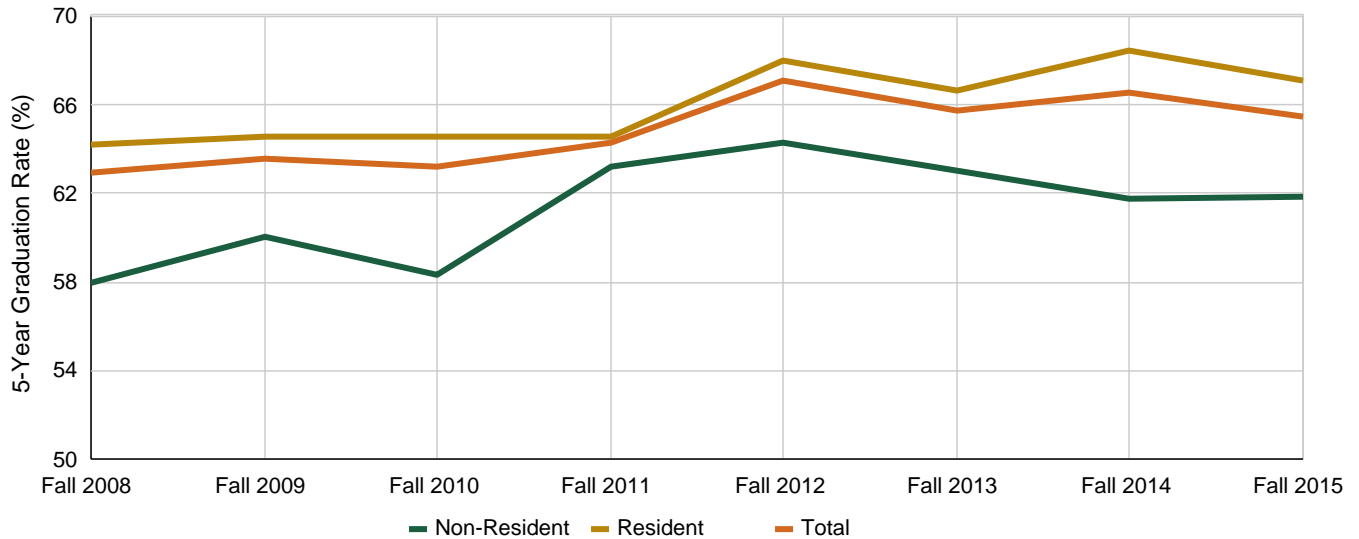

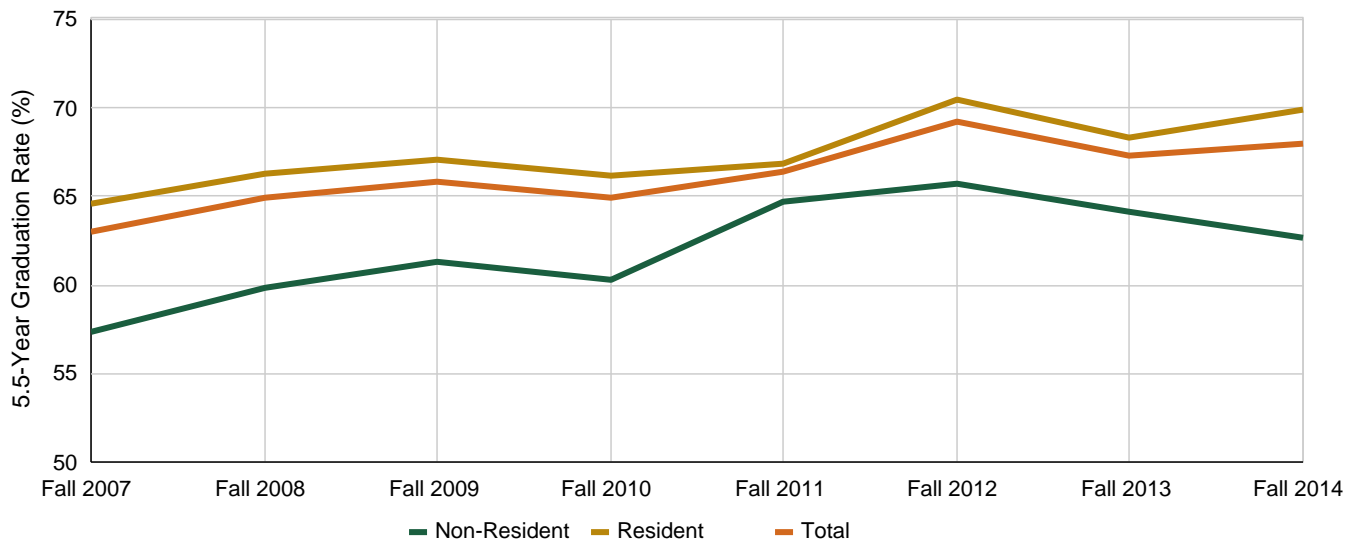

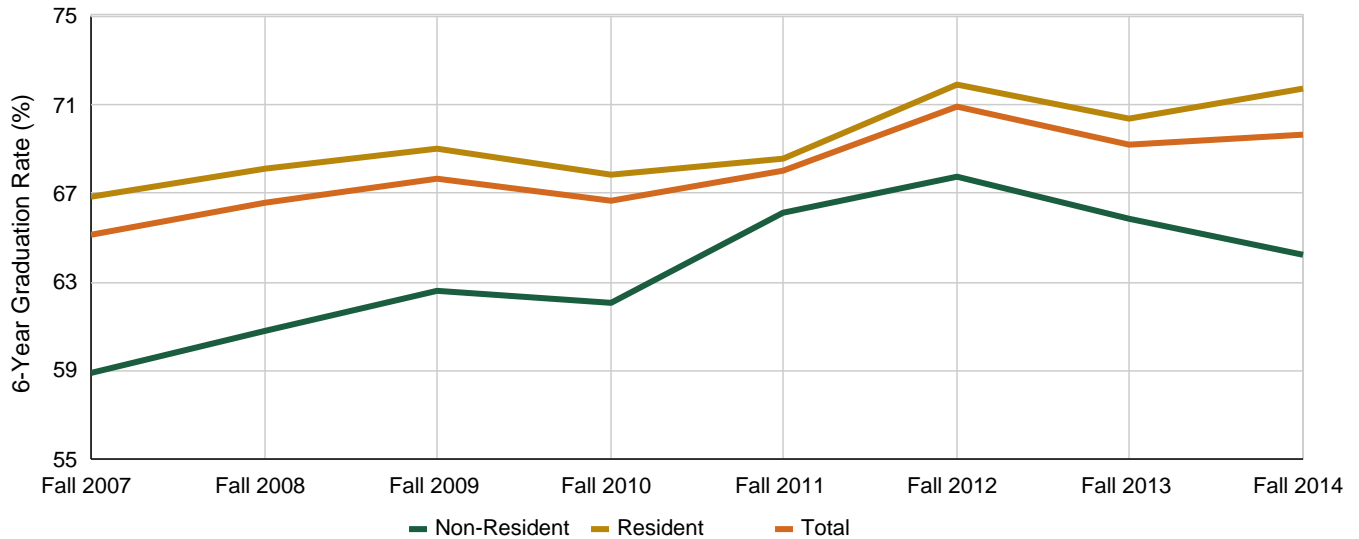

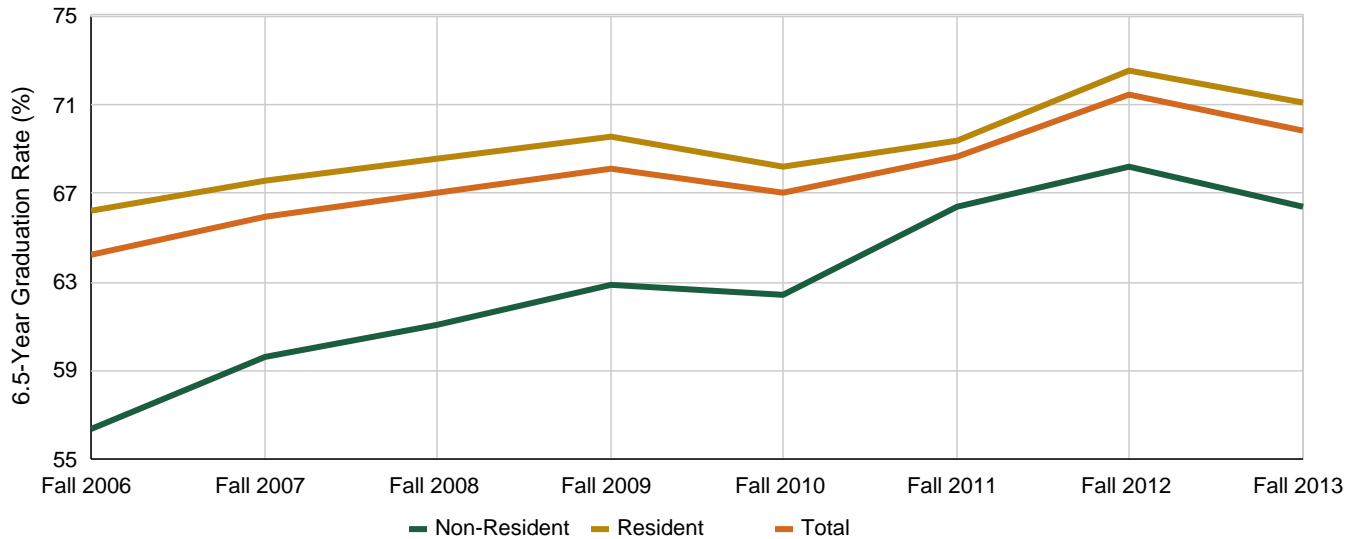

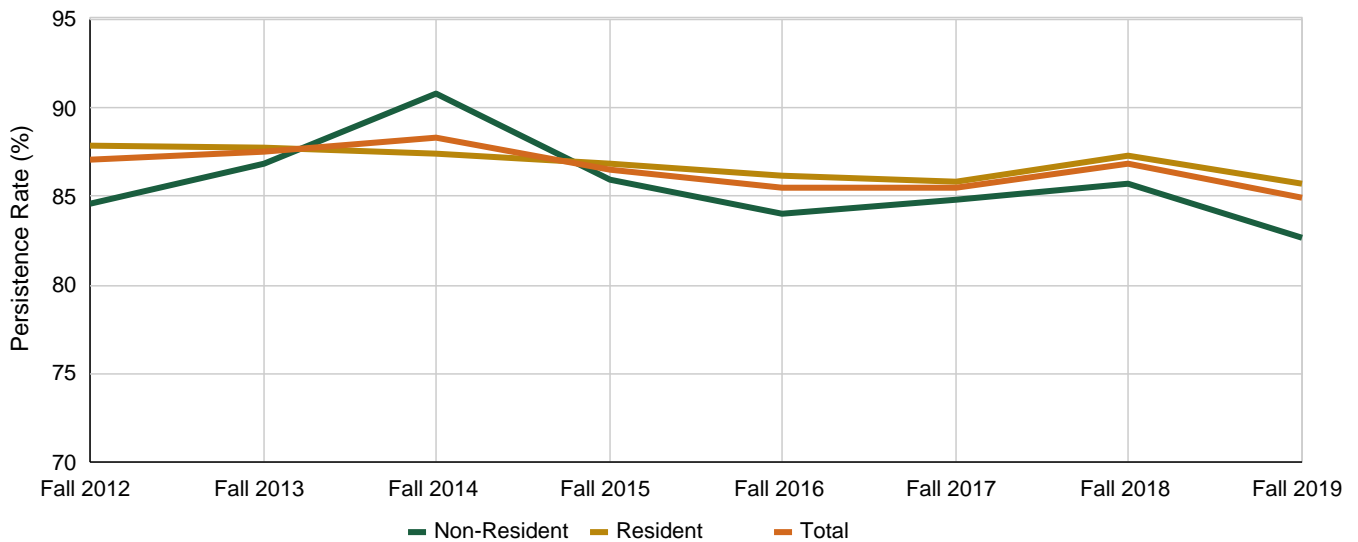

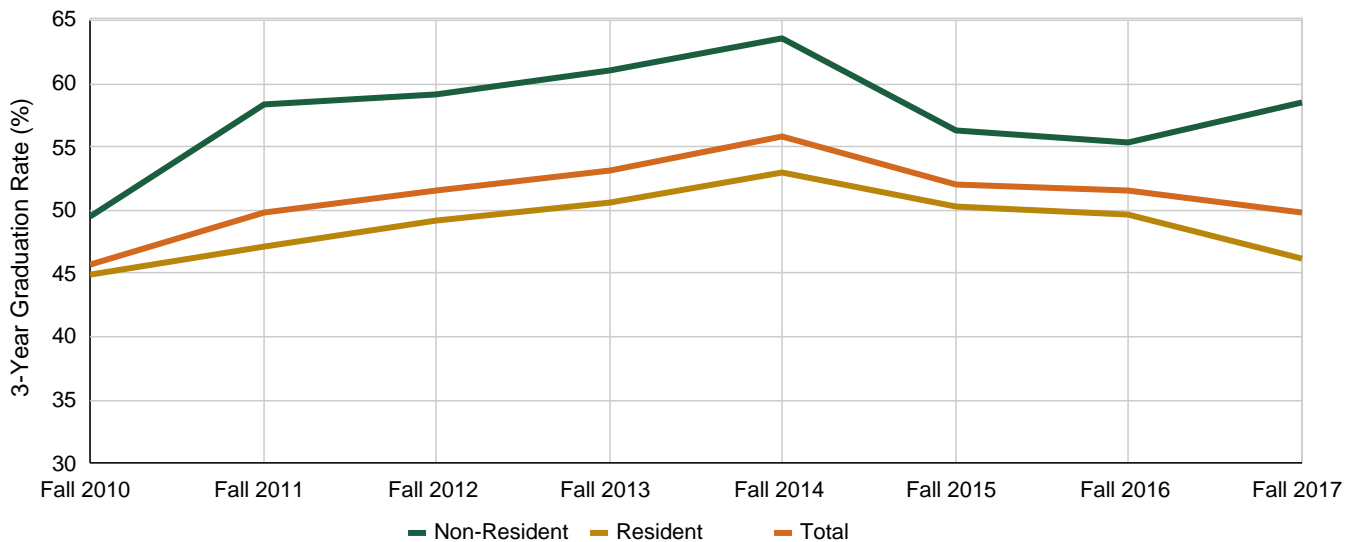

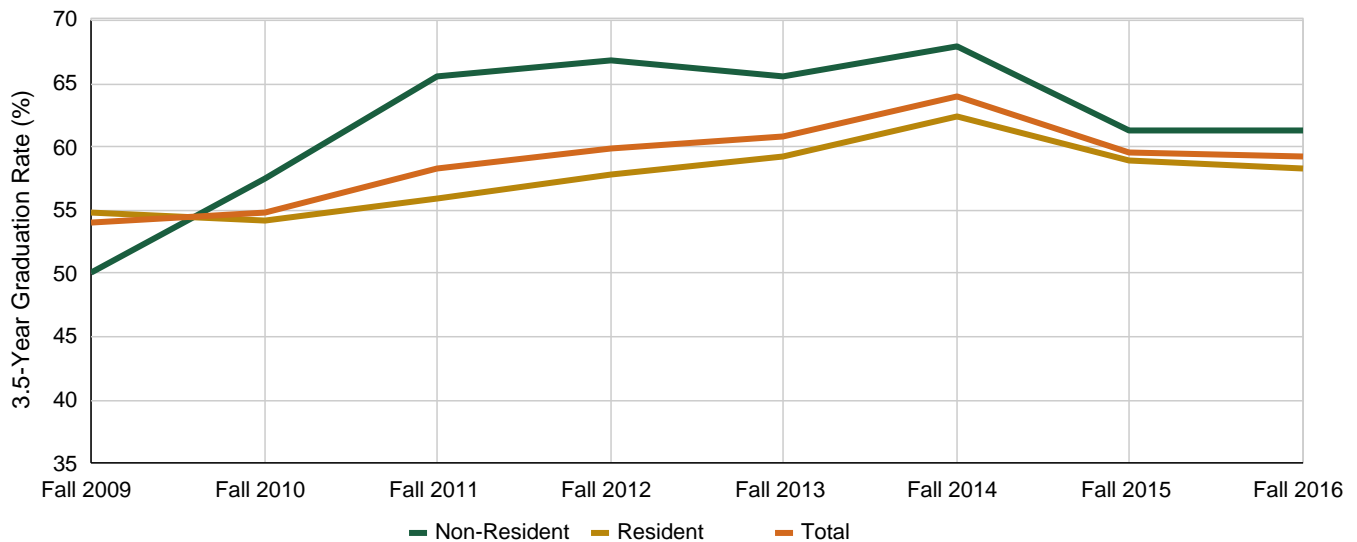

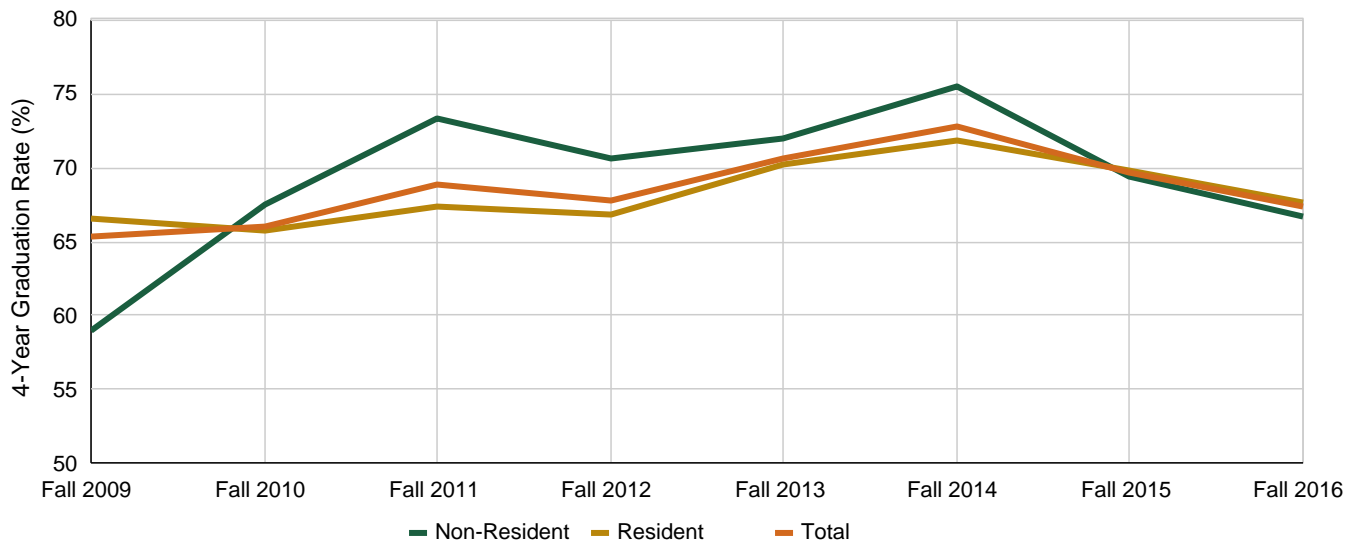

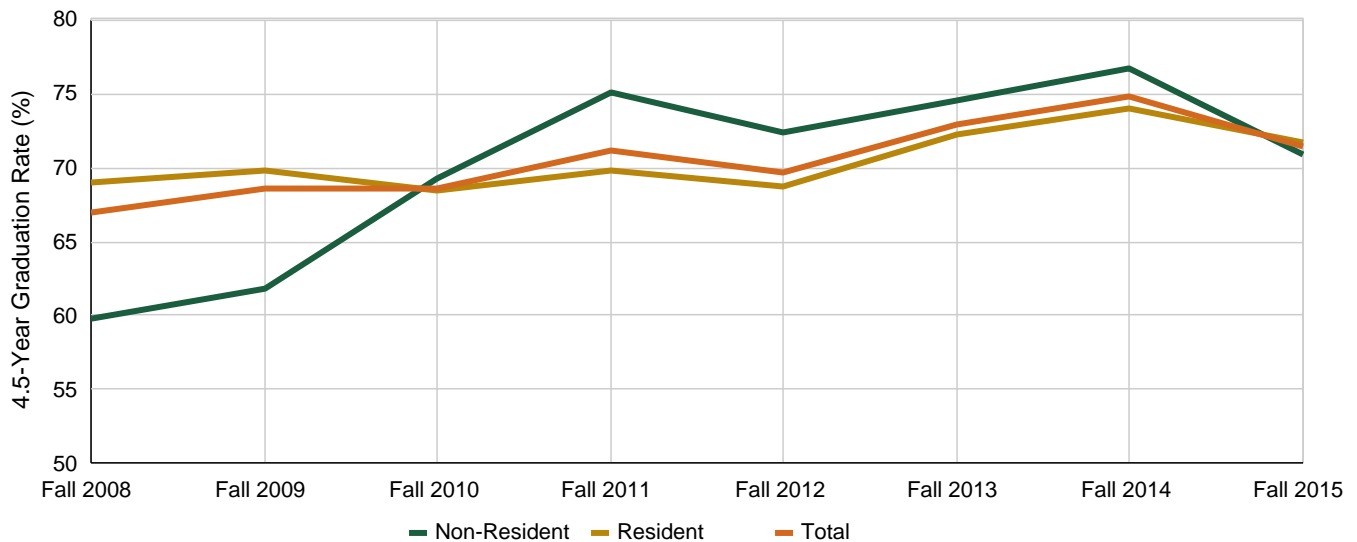

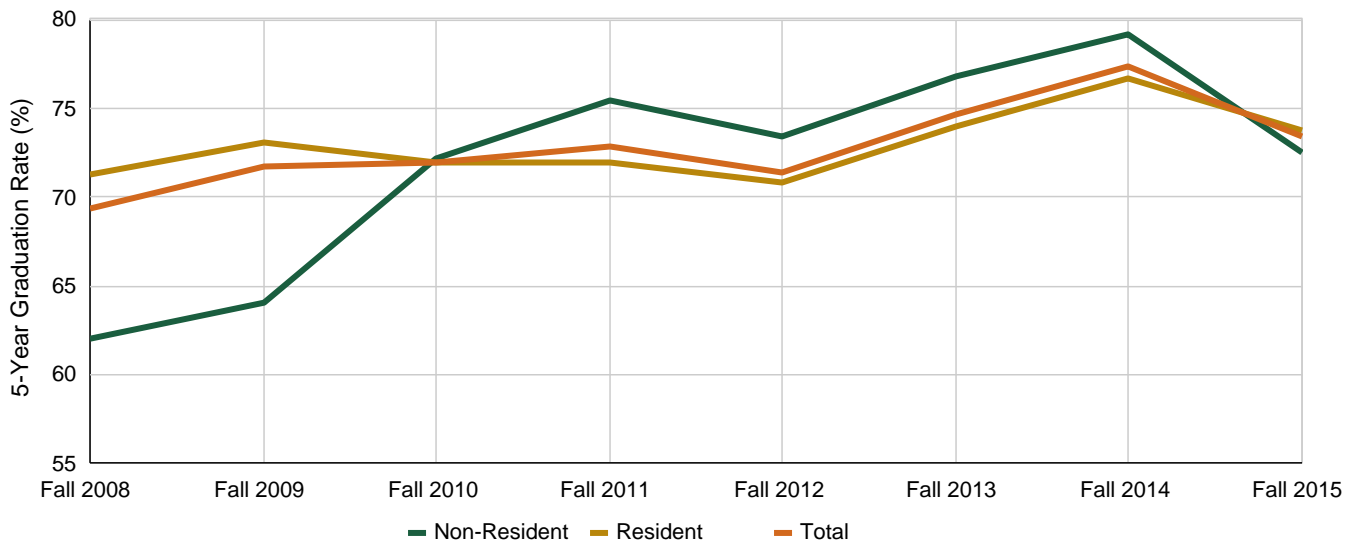
Transfer Students 4.5-Year Graduation by Residency - Comparison with Total

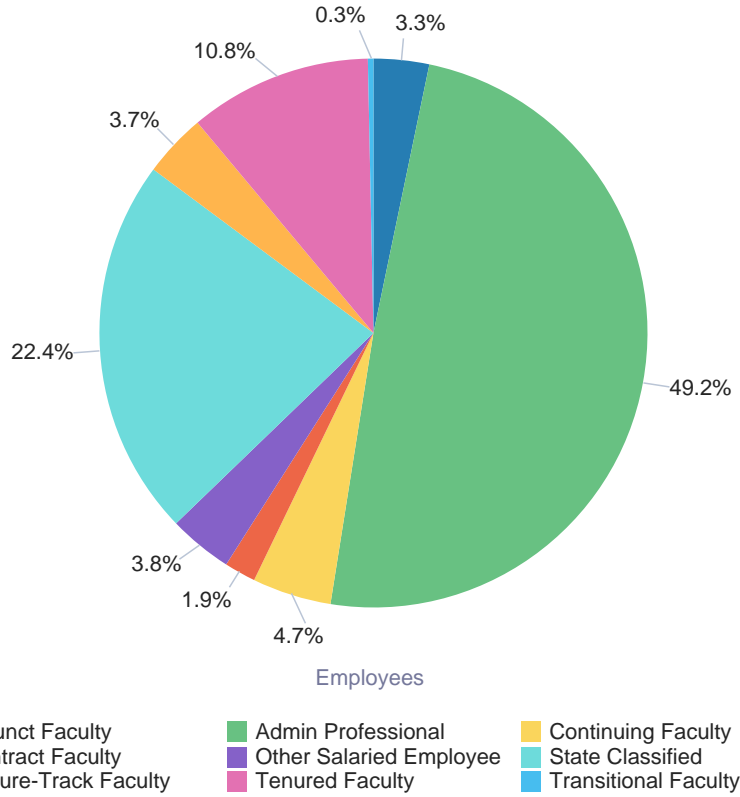

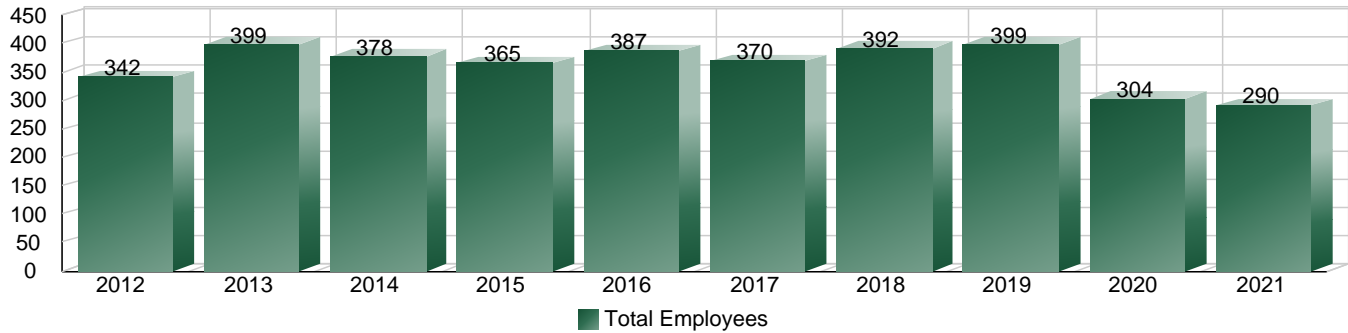

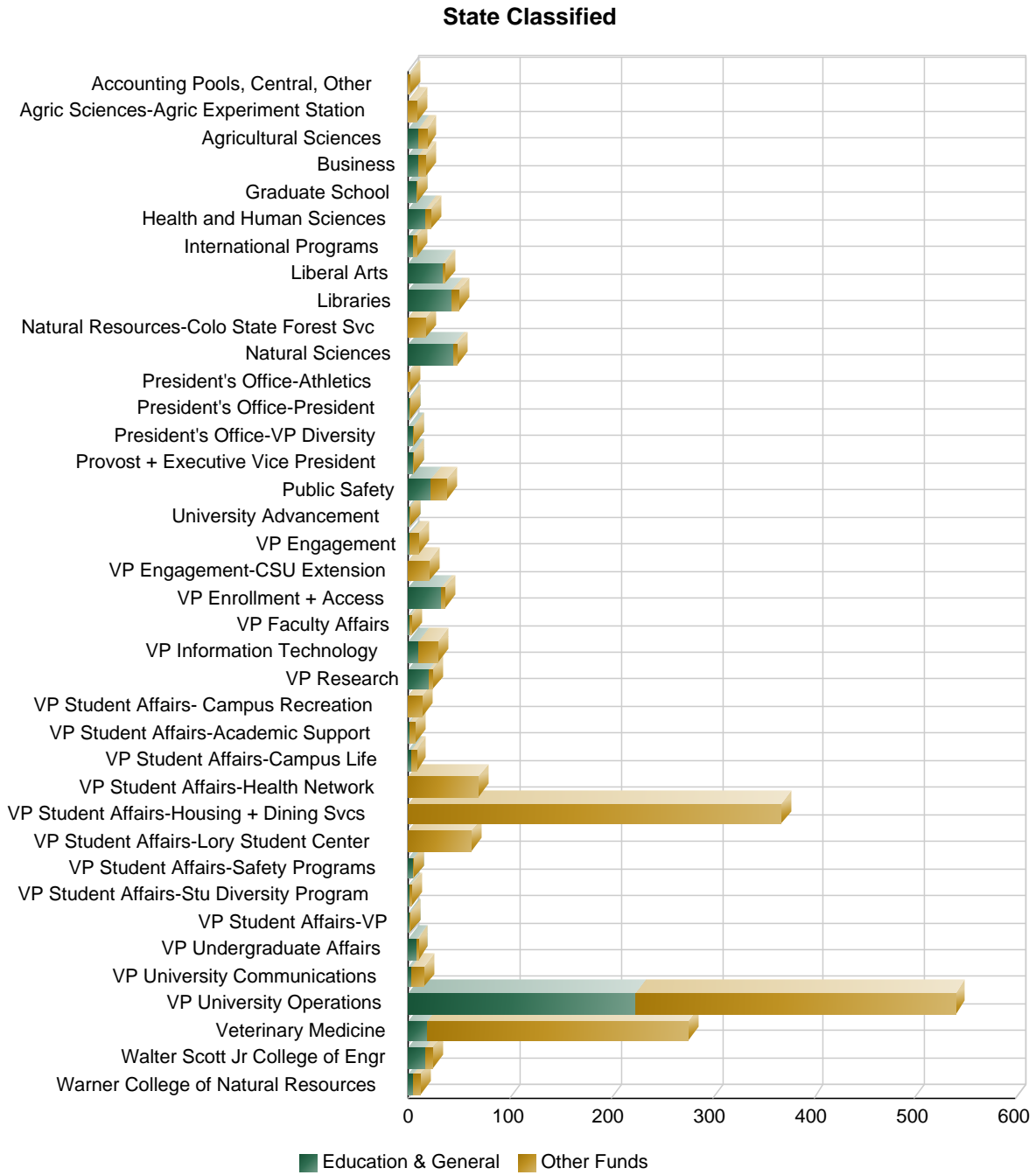
University Employees FTE by Unit - Fiscal Year 2020

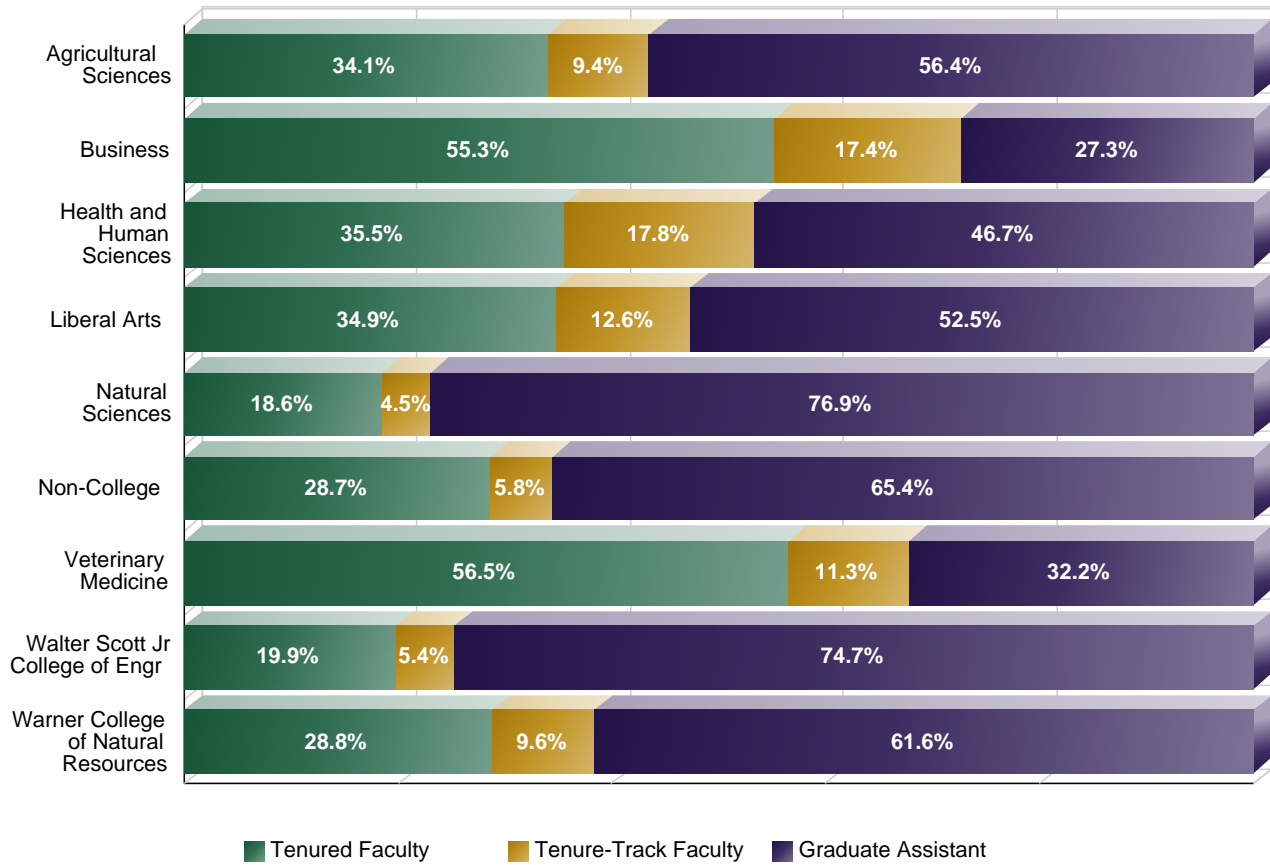
University Employees FTE by Unit - Fiscal Year 2020
