





Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Gender - Percent of Students



Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Minority Status - Percent of Students



Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and International Status - Percent of Students



Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Registration Type - Percent of Students



Fall 2021 Undergraduate Enrollment by College and Residency - Percent of Students



Fall 2021 Graduate Enrollment by College and Residency - Percent of Students






#### Fall 2021 CCHE Index Distribution



#### Fall 2013 to Fall 2021 Percent Change in New Freshman by Application College








Fall Term New Freshman First-Year CSU Grade Point Average - Fall 2020 Entering Freshmen (\* including summer starts)

First-Year CSU Grade Point Average and CDHE Index




#### First-Year CSU GPA Distribution - Number of Students








Fall 2021 Undergraduate Students by Credit Load






#### Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and Gender - Percent of Students



#### Degrees Awarded by Degree Category and Minority Status - Percent of Students



# History of New Freshman Retention and Graduation Rates (includes summer starts)




#### History of Transfer Students 2nd-Fall Persistence and Graduation Rates


#### Freshman Retention by Residency - Comparison with Total






















