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ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

FALL 1975

This fall, Colorado State University is operating under a semester system for the first time since 1944-45. Fall Semester 1975, On-Campus enrollment is 16,809 students, and increase of 11 students, or less than 0.1% over Fall Quarter 1974, when enrollment was 16,798 On-Campus students. Enrollment in Continuing Education and SURGE courses will be reported at a later date in the semester.

Last fall men represented 56.7% of the On-Campus enrollment and women 43.4%. This fall men represent 56.2% of the On-Campus enrollment and women 43.8%. Enrollment of men decreased 65 students or 0.7% and enrollment of women increased 76 students or 1.0%. Women students are increasing in number and percentage, continuing a trend which began in 1962.

On-Campus students are residents of all 50 states, the Canal Zone, Guam, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and 57 foreign countries. All of the Colorado Counties, except for one (Hinsdale), are represented by the On-Campus students. (Only twice in the University's history have students attended from all 63 Colorado counties, 1960 and 1972).

This Fall 90.0% of the students are attending full-time and 10.0% are attending part-time. Last Fall 91.2% were attending full-time and 8.8% were attending part-time. The proportion and total number of full-time students has decreased.

This Fall 71.4% of the students are Colorado residents and 28.6% are non-residents. This is a change from last years figures of 69.9% residents and 30.1% non-residents. There was a moderate increase in the number of residents.

The College of Engineering had the greatest percentage increase in enrollment from 1974 to 1975. The large decrease in enrollment in the College of Humanities and Social Sciences is due primarily to the removal of 1161 students who are enrolled this fall in the College of Professional Studies. After allowing for these students, the net enrollment decrease in the College of Humanities and Social Sciences is 387 or 7.2%.
