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ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

SPRING SEMESTER 1976

Colorado State University is operating under a semester system this year for the first time since 1944-45. Throughout this report, enrollment for Spring Semester 1976 will be compared with Winter Quarter 1975. Regular on-campus enrollment is 15,867 for Spring 1976, compared to 15,883 for Winter 1975.

Enrollment in Continuing Education and SURGE courses will be reported at a later date in the semester.

Last winter men represented 56.8% of the on-campus enrollment and women 43.2%. This spring semester men comprise 57.1% of the enrollment while women make up 42.9% of the on-campus student body. Enrollment of men increased by 45, or 0.3%, while the number of women on campus decreased by 61 or 0.9% compared with last winter quarter. This semester is the first time in several years that the number of women has declined from one year to the next.

All fifty states are represented by on-campus students, as well as the Canal Zone, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. There are students from sixty one foreign countries and from all Colorado counties except Hinsdale County.

This spring semester 90.5% of the students are attending full time and 9.5% are part-time students. During Winter Quarter 1975, full-time students made up 91.8% of the on-campus enrollment. The proportion and total number of full-time students has decreased.

This spring 71.9% of the students are residents and 28.1% are non-residents. Winter Quarter 1975, Colorado residents made up 70.3% of on-campus students and non-residents 29.7%. Resident students increased in number and percentage this spring.

The College of Engineering experienced the most growth during the past year. The large decline in the size of the College of Humanities and Social Sciences is accounted for in large part by the formation of the College of Professional Studies. When the two colleges are combined to maintain comparability with 1975, the decline in enrollment is 266 students, or 5.3%.
