SUMMER 1976

Colorado State University enrolled 5,820 students for the Summer Session 1976. This represents a decrease of 1,569, or 21.2%, from last summer's enrollment of 7,389. Of this summer's total enrollment, 4,760 were enrolled in Regular On-Campus courses and 1,185 were enrolled in Continuing Education courses (125 were enrolled in both On-Campus and Continuing Education courses).

Last summer men represented 59.4% of the on-campus enrollment and women 40.4%. This summer men made up 59.0% of on-campus students and women 41.0%. Enrollment of men decreased by 599 students, or 17.6%, and enrollment of women decreased by 378 students, or 16.2%.

On-campus students this summer were residents of 49 states (all but Maine), the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands and 51 foreign countries. All but 4 Colorado counties were represented. This summer 69.8% of on-campus students were Colorado residents and 30.2% were nonresidents. This represents a slight change from last summer when 69.5% of the students were residents.

Summer Session 1976 was eight weeks long, preceded by a three-week pre-session. On the average, students took fewer credits this summer than last when summer session was ten weeks long. The number of students enrolled for nine credits or more declined from 64.4% of total enrollment, to 33.4% this year.
