ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

SPRING SEMESTER 1977

The regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 16,726 students for Spring Semester 1977, an increase of 859 or 5.4% over the enrollment during Spring of 1976. Enrollment in Continuing Education and SURGE courses will be reported at a later date in the semester.

Last spring, men represented 57.1% of the on-campus enrollment and women 42.9%. Spring Semester 1977, men comprise 56.3% of the enrollment while women make up 43.7%. Enrollment of men increased by 356 or 3.9%, while the number of women on campus increased 503 or 7.4% compared with Spring 1976.

All 50 states are represented by on-campus students, as well as Guam, the Canal Zone, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. There are students from 64 foreign countries and from all but 3 Colorado counties.

This spring semester 90.2% of the students are attending full time and 9.8% are part-time students. During Spring Semester 1976, full-time students made up 90.5% of on-campus enrollment. The total number of full-time students increased over last spring although the proportion of all students attending full time has decreased.

This spring, 72.7% of the students are Colorado residents and 27.3% are nonresidents. Spring Semester 1976, Colorado residents made up 71.9% of the on-campus enrollment. Enrollment of resident students increased in both number and percentage this spring as it has for several years.

SUBJECT: Spring Semester 1977 Continuing Education and SURGE Statistics

Attached you will find statistics for Continuing Education and SURGE students, based on enrollment at the end of Spring Semester. Please note that these 2,720 students are only those enrolled in degree credit (academic transfer credit) courses. It should also be noted that these statistics are student oriented. That is, they are based upon the students major area, and not the area in which the course is taken. Thus an engineering student who is enrolled in a continuing education business course would be counted with the engineering students and not the business students.

The only exception to this is the special student category. These students are classified as 'specials' for their major. They have not been admitted to a degree program. They are taking a class within the college they are a 'special' in. Thus, a special in Humanities and Social Sciences is a non-degree student taking a class offered by that college.
