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## ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

FALL 1977

Fall Semester 1977 on-campus enrollment is 17,812 students, an increase of 386 students, or 2.2% over Fall Semester 1976, when enrollment was 17,426 on-campus students. Enrollment in Continuing Education and SURGE courses will be reported at a later date in the semester.

This fall men represent 55.2% of the on-campus enrollment and women 44.8%. Last fall, the percentage of men was 56.2%, and women 43.8%. Enrollment of men increased by 48 students or .5%, and enrollment of women increased by 338 students or 4.4%. Women students have increased in number and percentage every year since 1962.

On-campus students are residents of all 50 states, the Canal Zone, Guam, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and 68 foreign countries. All of the Colorado Counties, except for three, are represented by the on-campus students. (Only twice in the University's history have students attended from all 63 Colorado Counties, 1960 and 1972).

This fall 91.4% of the students are attending full-time and 8.6% are attending part-time. The total number of full-time students has increased since last fall, and the percentages of students attending full-time has also increased from last fall, when 90.0% were full-time students.

This fall 73.0% of the students are Colorado residents and 27.0% are nonresidents. This is a change from last years figures of 72.6% residents and 27.4% nonresidents. There was a sizable increase in the number of residents, while the number of nonresidents increased only slightly.

REMARKS:

Attached you will find statistics for Continuing Education and SURGE students, based on enrollment at the end of Fall Semester. Please note that these 2312 students are only those enrolled in degree credit (academic transfer credit) courses. It should be also noted that these statistics are student oriented. That is, they are based upon the students major area, and not the area in which the course is taken. Thus an engineering student who is enrolled in a continuing education business course would be counted with the engineering students and not the business students.

The only exception to this is the special student category. Students classified as specials are non-degree students who do not have a regular major. They are counted as specials for the college in which they are taking courses.
