ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

SPRING SEMESTER 1978

The regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 16,312 students for Spring Semester 1978, a decrease of 414, or 2.5%, from Spring 1977. This report does not include enrollment in Continuing Education and SURGE courses, which will be reported later in the semester.

Last spring, men represented 56.3% of the enrollment and women 43.7%. Spring 1978, men comprise 55.3% of the enrollment and women make up 44.7%. Enrollment of men decreased by 405, or 4.3%, while enrollment of women dropped by only 9, or 0.1%, compared with Spring of 1977.

On-campus students represent all fifty states, as well as the District of Columbia, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands. Sixty-eight foreign countries are represented, and there are students from all but two of Colorado's 63 counties.

This spring, 90.4% of students are attending full-time and 9.6% are part-time students. During Spring Semester of 1977, full-time students made up 90.2% of the student body. Although the proportion of students attending full-time increased, the absolute number of full-time students declined.

*Definition of full-time: Undergraduates enrolled for 12 or more credits, graduates enrolled for 9 or more credits, professional veterinary medicine students enrolled for 15 or more credits.

This spring 74.0% of the students are Colorado residents, and 26.0% are nonresidents (for tuition purposes). The proportion of nonresidents declined from 27.3% in Spring of 1977.

The proportion of freshmen declined this year, while juniors and Ph.D. level students make up a larger proportion of the enrollment.
