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## ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

SUMMER 1978

Colorado State University enrolled 5645 regular on-campus students during the 1978 Summer Session and 1103 students were enrolled in Continuing Education courses. Regular on-campus enrollment showed a slight increase from last summer, while Continuing Education enrollment experienced substantial growth. (In the table below, some students appear in more than one category, so the total student body would be less than the sum of all categories.)

Last summer men represented 57% of on-campus enrollment and women 43%. This summer, 56% of on-campus students are men, and 44% are women. Enrollment of men increased by 11 students, or 0.4%, while enrollment of women climbed 181 or 7.8%.

All 50 states are represented by this summer's on-campus students as well as 64 foreign countries and 60 of Colorado's 63 counties. This summer, 72.2% of on-campus students were Colorado residents, a higher percentage than last summer when 70.8% of the students were residents.
