ENROLLMENT STATISTICS
SPRING SEMESTER 1979

The regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 16,634 students for Spring Semester 1979, an increase of 322, or 2.0%, from Spring 1978. This report does not include enrollment in Continuing Education and SURGE courses, which will be reported later in the semester.

Last spring, men represented 55.3% of the enrollment and women 44.7%. Spring 1979, men comprise 54.8% of the enrollment and women make up 45.2%. Enrollment of men increased by 102, or 1.1%, while enrollment of women grew by 220, or 3.0%, compared with Spring of 1978.

On-campus students represent all fifty states, as well as the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, and the Canal Zone. Seventy-one foreign countries are represented, and there are students from all but two of Colorado's 63 counties.

This spring, 89% of students are attending full-time and 11.0% are part-time students. During Spring Semester of 1978, full-time students made up 90.4% of the student body. Although the proportion of students attending full-time decreased, the absolute number of full-time students rose slightly.

* Definition of full-time: Undergraduates enrolled for 12 or more credits, graduates enrolled for 9 or more credits, professional veterinary medicine students enrolled for 15 or more credits.

This spring 73.6% of the students are Colorado residents, and 26.4% are nonresidents (for tuition purposes). The proportion of nonresidents rose slightly from 26.0% in Spring of 1978.

Enrollment by classification, with percent of total enrollment is shown below for Spring 1978 and Spring 1979. The Graduate-I classification includes master's level graduate students and professional level students in veterinary

medicine (DVM program). Graduate-II represents Ph.D. level students. The number and proportion of sophomores declined slightly this year, while seniors and Level I graduate students make up a larger proportion of the enrollment.
