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ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

SUMMER 1979

Colorado State University enrolled 5877 regular on-campus students during the 1979 Summer Session and 1098 students were enrolled in Continuing Education courses. Regular on-campus enrollment showed an increase from last summer, while Continuing Education enrollment remained about the same. (In the table below, some students appear in more than one category, so the total student body would be less than the sum of all categories.)

Last summer men represented 56% of on-campus enrollment and women 44%. This summer, 54% of on-campus students are men, and 46% are women. Enrollment of men increased by 15 students, or 0.5%, while enrollment of women climbed 217 or 8.7%.

All 50 states are represented by this summer's on-campus students as well as 65 foreign countries and 60 of Colorado's 63 counties. This summer, 72.8% of on-campus students were Colorado residents, a slightly higher percentage than last summer when 72.2% of the students were residents.
