FALL 1979

Fall Semester 1979 on-campus enrollment is 18,255 students, an increase of 32 students, or .2% over Fall Semester 1978, when enrollment was 18,223 on-campus students. Enrollment in Continuing Education and SURGE courses will be reported at a later date in the semester.

This fall men represent 53.3% of the on-campus enrollment and women 46.7%. Last fall, the percentage of men was 54.8% and women 45.2%. Enrollment of men decreased by 241 students or 24% and enrollment of women increased by 273 students or 3.3%. Women students have increased in number and percentage every year since 1962.

On-campus students are residents of all 50 states, the Canal Zone, Guam, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands, and 71 foreign countries. All of the Colorado Counties are represented by the on-campus students.

This fall 90.2% of the students are attending full-time and 9.8% are attending part-time. The total number of full-time students increased again this year, as well as the percentage of students attending full-time. (The definition of a full-time student is an undergraduate taking 12 credits or more, a graduate student taking 9 credits or more, or a professional-level student taking 15 credits or more.)

Enrollment by registration type is shown in the following table for 1978 and 1979. A slightly higher percentage of students are continuing students and readmits this year, while the proportion accounted for by new freshmen declined slightly. It should be noted that freshmen admission policies were more selective this year than in the past, possibly accounting for the decline in new freshmen.
