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ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

SUMMER 1980

The 1980 Summer Session regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 5702 students. This is a decrease of 175 students, or 3%, from the 1979 Summer Session when 5877 students were enrolled. The decrease is due to controls being placed on admissions to help CSU meet the 1980-81 budgeted FTE enrollment.

This summer 53.2 percent of the on-campus enrollment are men and 46.8 percent are women. This represents a 0.8 percent decrease in the percentage of men from last summer and a 0.8 percent increase in the percentage of women.

The 5702 students enrolled represent all 50 states, 55 foreign countries and 60 of Colorado's 63 counties. Colorado residents make up 77.2 percent of the on-campus enrollment and non-residents 22.8 percent. This represents a substantial increase over last summer when 72.8% of the enrolled students were Colorado residents.

On the average, students enrolled for Summer 1980 are taking fewer credits than those enrolled Summer of 1979. The proportion of students enrolled for 9 or more credits has decreased from 27.4 percent of total enrolled last year to 23.5 percent this summer.

Enrollment by classification is shown below. A larger proportion of the undergraduate students are upper-division (junior, senior) this summer, with a corresponding smaller proportion being lower-division (freshman, sophomore). Overall, there was a slight drop in the proportion of graduate students enrolled.

Enrollment by classification with percentage change from 1979 to 1980 is shown below. Once again, freshman and sophomore numbers declined and junior and senior numbers increased for enrolled students. The total decline in graduate students can all be accounted for by the drop in graduate level I students this summer compared to last summer.

Enrollment by registration type with percentage change from 1979 to 1980 is displayed below. The number of new undergraduate students for Summer 1980 is substantially lower than for 1979, this being a result of lower admission goals to meet state enrollment limits and an anticipated increase in continuing undergraduates over Summer 1979. The number of new and readmitted graduate students increased slightly over last year while the number of continuing graduate students decreased.
