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ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

FALL 1980

Fall Semester 1980 regular on-campus enrollment is 18,083 students, a decrease of 172 students, or 0.9 percent from Fall Semester 1979, when enrollment was 18,255 regular on-campus students. This was a planned decrease based on a reduction of the FTE allocation for fiscal year 1980-81.

This fall men represent 52.8 percent of the regular on-campus enrollment and women represent 47.2 percent. Last fall the percentage of men was 53.3 percent and women 46.7 percent. Enrollment of men decreased by 183 students, or 1.9 percent, and enrollment of women increased by 11 students, or 0.1 percent, compared to Fall of 1979.

On-campus students represent all fifty states, as well as the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, Virgin Islands, and forty-nine foreign countries. All of the Colorado counties are represented by the regular on-campus students.

This fall 89.7 percent of the students are attending full-time and 10.3 percent are attending part-time. The percentage of full-time students as well as the total number decreased from last fall. (The definition of a full-time student is an undergraduate taking 12 or more credits, a graduate student taking 9 or more credits, or a professional-level student taking 15 or more credits.)

Enrollment by classification with percent change from Fall 1979 to Fall 1980 is displayed below. The largest change in undergraduates occurred in the freshman class with a decrease of 398 students from Fall 1979. The graduate level II students enrolled increased by 68, or 6.7 percent, over Fall 1979.

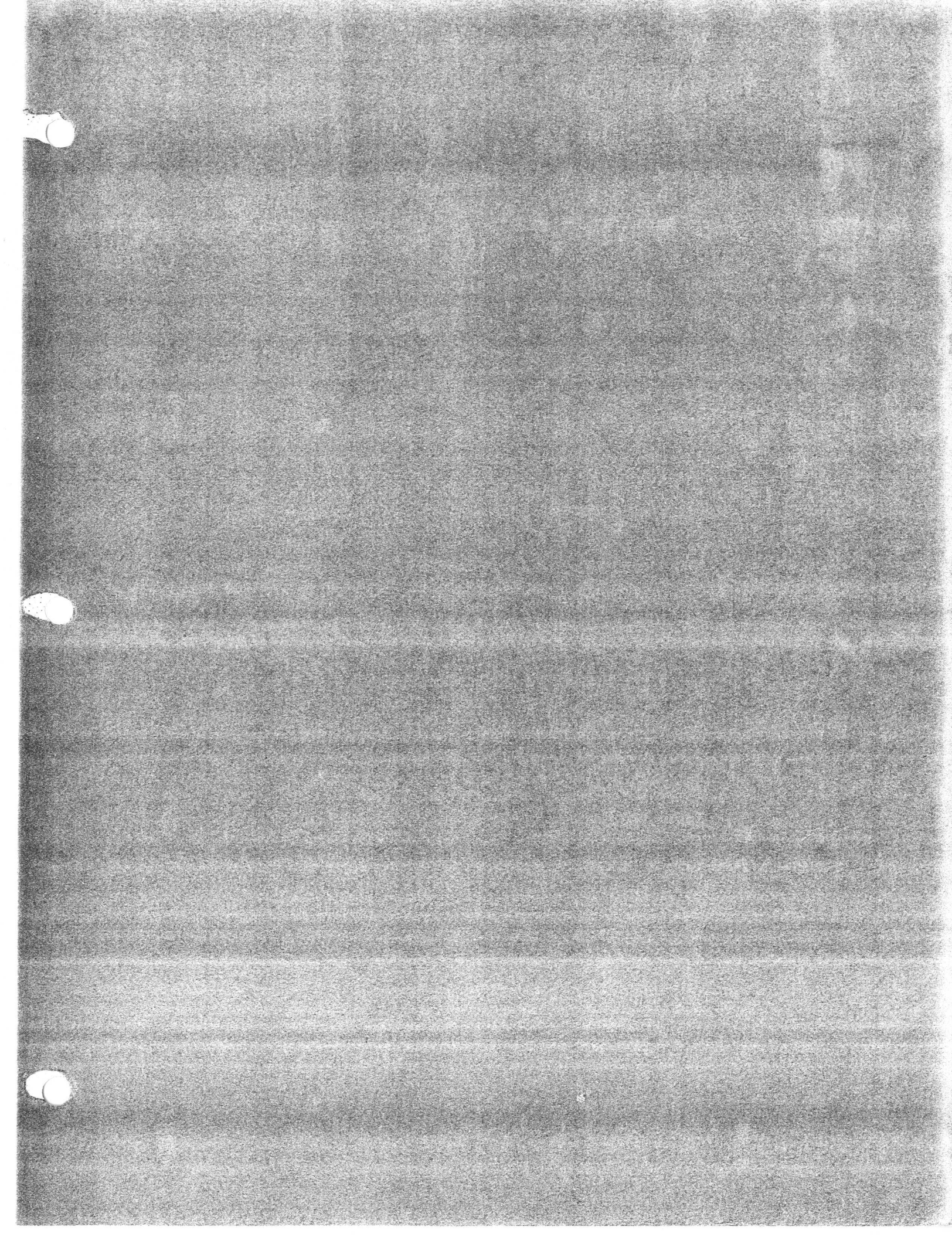
