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ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

SUMMER 1981

The 1981 Summer Session regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 5,653 students. This is a decrease of 49 students, or 0.9%, from 1980 Summer Session when 5,702 students were enrolled. The decrease is due to controls being placed on admissions to help meet the 1981-82 budgeted FTE enrollment.

This summer 51.3 percent of the on-campus enrollment are men and 48.7 percent are women. This represents a 1.9 percentage point drop in the percent of men from last summer and a 1.9 percentage point increase in the percent of women.

The 5,653 students enrolled represent all 50 states, 62 foreign countries, and 61 of Colorado's 63 counties. Colorado residents make up 79.4 percent of the on-campus enrollment and nonresidents, 20.6 percent. This represents an increase of 2.2 percentage points in Colorado residents enrolled over Summer 1980.

A larger number of students enrolled for Summer 1981 are taking fewer than 9 credits than did in Summer 1980; the increase being all at the undergraduate level. The proportion of students enrolled for 9 or more credits has decreased from 23.5 percent of the total enrolled last summer to 21.9 percent this summer.

Enrollment by classification is shown below. For undergraduate students, freshmen and seniors increased in proportions of the total enrollment with sophomores and juniors showing a slight decline in proportions compared to Summer 1980. Both Graduate - I and Graduate - II proportions declined from their 1980 levels.

The table below shows the change in enrollment by registration type from Summer 1980 to Summer 1981. Overall, undergraduate enrollment increased by 2 percent over Summer 1980 with transfers showing the largest percentage increase. The total graduate student enrollment declined by 6.6 percent from Summer 1980 with specials showing the greatest decline.
