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## ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

FALL 1981

Fall Semester 1981 regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 18,651 students, an increase of 568 students, or 3.1 percent over Fall Semester 1980, when enrollment was 18,083 regular on-campus students.

This fall men represent 52.0 percent of the regular on-campus enrollment, and women represent 48.0 percent. This represents a 0.8 percentage point drop in the percent of men from last fall, and a 0.8 percentage point increase in the percent of women.

On-campus students represent all fifty states, as well as the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, Virgin Islands, and seventy-eight foreign countries. All of the Colorado counties are represented by the regular on-campus students.

This fall 89.5 percent of the students are attending full time, and 10.5 percent are attending part time. This represents a slight drop, 0.2 percentage points, in full-time students from last fall. (The definition of a full-time student is an undergraduate taking 12 or more credits, a graduate student taking 9 or more credits, or a professional-level student taking 15 or more credits.)

The number and proportion of freshman and senior undergraduate students are higher this fall than last fall. The proportion of Graduate - I level students is slightly higher this fall than last fall, while the proportion of Graduate - II level students is down compared to last fall.

Enrollment by classification with percentage change from Fall 1980 to Fall 1981 displayed next. Both the freshman and senior classes show substantial increases over Fall 1980 with the largest percentage increase being in the freshman class. The sophomore class shows the largest percentage decrease from Fall 1980. For graduate students, Graduate - I level enrollment increased almost 10 percent over Fall 1980, while Graduate - II level enrollment shows a small decrease compared to last fall.

Shown below is enrollment by college with percent of total enrollment for Fall 1980 and Fall 1981. Those colleges showing increases in proportion of total enrollment compared to last fall are Business, Natural Sciences, and Professional Studies. The largest increase in proportion of total enrollment over Fall 1980 is in Professional Studies, while the largest decrease is in Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences. This can be largely accounted for due to the social work major switching from Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences to Professional Studies this fall.

The change in enrollment from Fall 1980 to Fall 1981 by college is shown in the next table. The college of Professional Studies shows the largest increase in enrollment in both number and percentage, and Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences shows the largest decrease compared to Fall 1980. Again this is mostly due to Social Work switching to Professional Studies. Among the other colleges, Engineering, Forestry and Natural Resources, Home Economics, and Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences show only slight changes compared to last fall. Business, Natural Sciences and Agricultural Sciences show significant increases over Fall 1980.
