ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

SUMMER 1982

The 1982 Summer Session regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 5,883 students. This is an increase of 230 students, or 4.1%, from Summer Session 1981 when 5,653 students were enrolled.

This summer 51.3 percent of the on-campus enrollment are men and 48.7 percent are women.

The 5,883 students enrolled represent 48 states, 62 foreign countries, and 60 of Colorado's 63 counties. Colorado residents make up 81.6 percent of the on-campus enrollment and nonresidents, 18.4 percent. This represents an increase of 2.2 percentage points in Colorado residents enrolled over Summer 1981.

A larger number of students enrolled for Summer 1982 are taking fewer than 9 credits than did in Summer 1981; the increase being at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. The proportion of students enrolled for 9 or more credits has decreased from 21.9 percent of the total enrolled last summer to 17.8 percent this summer.

Enrollment by classification is shown below. For undergraduate students, freshmen and sophomores increased in proportions of the total enrollment with juniors and seniors showing a slight decline in proportions compared to Summer 1981. Graduate - I level showed an increase and Graduate - II showed a decrease from their 1981 levels of enrollment.

Enrollment by college, with percent of total enrollment, is displayed below. The College of Professional Studies showed the largest increase in proportion of enrollment over last summer. The College of Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences showed the largest proportionate decline in enrollment compared to Summer 1981. This is due largely to the social work major changing from Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences to Professional Studies in Fall 1981.

Following is the change in enrollment from Summer 1981 to Summer 1982 by college. The College of Professional Studies showed the largest increase over Summer 1981, 32.8%. The change of social work from Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences to Professional Studies explains 8% of this increase. With the change above taken into account, Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences experienced less than a 2% decline rather than the 8% shown in the table.

The table below shows the change in enrollment by registration type from Summer 1981 to Summer 1982. Overall, undergraduate enrollment increased by 2.7 percent over Summer 1981 with new freshmen showing the largest percentage increase. The total graduate student enrollment increased by 7.2 percent from Summer 1981 with new and readmitted students showing the greatest increase.
