FALL 1982

Fall Semester 1982 regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 18,909 students, an increase of 258 students, or 1.4 percent over Fall Semester 1981, when enrollment was 18,651 regular on-campus students.

This fall men represent 51.9 percent of the regular on-campus enrollment, and women represent 48.1 percent. This represents a 0.1 percentage point drop in the percent of men from last fall, and a 0.1 percentage point increase in the percent of women.

On-campus students represent all 50 states, as well as the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, Virgin Islands, and 78 foreign countries. All of the Colorado counties are represented by the regular on-campus students.

Colorado residents make up 78.4 percent of the on-campus enrollment and nonresidents, 21.6 percent. The percentage of Colorado residents increased 1.2 percentage points over the 77.2 percent of Fall 1981.

This fall 88.4 percent of the students are attending full time, and 11.6 percent are attending part time. This represents a drop of 1.1 percentage points in full-time students from last fall. Of the resident students, 88.5 percent are attending full time, and 88.0 percent of the nonresident students are attending full time. (The definition of a full-time student is an undergraduate taking 12 or more credits, a graduate student taking 9 or more credits, or a professional-level student taking 15 or more credits.)

Enrollment by classification and by residency with percentage change between Fall 1981 to Fall 1982 is shown. The number of Colorado residents increased by 3.0 percent with sophomores and Graduate I levels showing the largest increases, while freshmen showed the only decrease. The number of nonresident students decreased by 4.0 percent. The largest decrease was among juniors and seniors. Freshmen were the only nonresident classification which had an increase from Fall 1981.

The change in enrollment from Fall 1981 to Fall 1982 by college is shown in the next table. The college of Natural Sciences shows the largest increase in enrollment in both number and percentage, and Agriculture shows the largest decrease compared to Fall 1981. Among the other colleges, Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences and Professional Studies also show significant increases over Fall 1981.
