SUMMER 1984

The 1984 Summer Session regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 5,091 students. This is a decrease of 380 students, or 6.9 percent, from Summer Session 1983 when 5,471 students were enrolled.

This summer 48.6 percent of the on-campus enrollment are men and 51.4 percent are women.

The 5,091 students enrolled represent 49 states, 72 foreign countries, and 61 of Colorado's 63 counties. Colorado residents make up 81.3 percent of the on-campus enrollment and nonresidents 18.7 percent. This represents a decrease of 1.3 percentage points in Colorado residents over Summer 1983.

A fewer number of students enrolled for Summer 1984 are taking less than 9 credits than did in Summer 1983; the decrease being at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. The proportion of students enrolled for 9 or more credits is 19.1 percent. This is an increase from Summer 1983, when 17.8 percent of the students took 9 or more credits.
