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ENROLLMENT STATISTICS

FALL 1984

Fall Semester 1984 regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 18,094 students, a decrease of 201 students or 1.1 percent below Fall Semester 1983, when enrollment was 18,295 regular on-campus students.

This fall, men represent 52.2 percent of the on-campus enrollment, and women represent 47.8 percent. These are the same percentages of men and women as last fall.

On-campus students represent all 50 states, as well as the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Guam, and 88 foreign countries. All of Colorado's 63 counties are represented by the regular on-campus students.

Colorado residents make up 81.4 percent of the on-campus enrollment and nonresidents, 18.6 percent. This percentage of Colorado residents increased 1.1 percentage points over the 80.3 percent of Fall 1983.

This fall 88.6 percent of the students are attending full-time, and 11.4 percent are attending part-time. This is a 0.2 percentage point increase over Fall 1983 in the percent of full-time students. Of the resident students, 88.7 percent are attending full-time, and of the nonresidents, 88.4 percent are attending full-time. (The definition of a full-time student is an undergraduate taking 12 or more credits, a graduate student taking 9 or more credits, or a professional-level student taking 15 or more credits.)
