SUMMER 1985

The 1985 Summer Session regular on-campus enrollment at Colorado State University is 5,318 students. This is an increase of 227 students, or 4.5 percent, from Summer Session 1984 when 5,091 students were enrolled.

This summer 49.8 percent of the on-campus enrollment are men and 50.2 percent are women.

The 5,318 students enrolled represent 47 states, the District of Columbia, Guam, and Puerto Rico; 69 foreign countries; and 59 of Colorado's 63 counties. Colorado residents make up 82.1 percent of the on-campus enrollment and nonresidents comprise 17.9 percent. This represents an increase of 0.8 percentage points in Colorado residents over Summer 1984.

A greater number of students enrolled for Summer 1985 are taking less than 9 credits than did in Summer 1984; the increase being at the undergraduate level only. The proportion of students enrolled for 9 or more credits is 17.1 percent. This is a decrease from Summer 1984, when 19.1 percent of the students took 9 or more credits.
