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DIRECTOR'S REMARKS

The 2024 CSU Trials are in the books. We had significant color extending all the way into the end of October! The 2024 summer was a bit more normal, compared to 2023, in that, we had a considerably drier summer and warmer temperatures on average, especially in June, with the thermostat being turned up quickly! This translated into a couple periods of increased irrigation frequency, to assist with establishing the plantings. For much of the summer, the Fort Collins area was under abnormally dry to moderate drought conditions, and we are currently in extreme drought conditions. Japanese beetles continue to be one of our major pest problems.

We had 28 companies participate in this season's trials, entering 127 new entries of herbaceous perennials. We are evaluating a total of 268 entries currently planted for evaluation in the perennial beds.

Plants were evaluated for several growth parameters and data were collected every two weeks from ~May through September. Entries were also evaluated by some members of the Perennial Trial Subcommittee. The subcommittee met on November 21, 2024 to review data and photos for plants entered in 2022. The committee evaluated 23 of the top rated 2022 entries and selected 9 as 2024 "Top Performers." A "Top Performer" exhibits nearly 100% survival after two winters/three growing seasons and received high ratings for different plant growth parameters.

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TRIAL GARDEN MISSION AND PURPOSE

Our mission is to provide education, research and outreach to students, community members, industry professionals and anyone else with a desire to learn.

The purpose of the flower trial garden is to evaluate the performance of flower varieties under our unique Rocky Mountain environmental conditions. Our growing conditions are characterized by high altitude (~5,000 ft), intense solar radiation, drying winds, severe hailstorms, large fluctuations between day and night temperatures, season-long need for irrigation and heavy clay soils. Plants are evaluated based on plant vigor, uniformity, floriferousness and tolerance to environmental and biotic stresses. Performances of these varieties are judged by selected students, faculty, industry representatives, public horticulturalists and advanced Master Gardeners.

A summary of these evaluations is published in this Trial Performance Report at the end of the season so that the information can be used by the horticulture industry and the public. This report will be distributed to all participating companies and these results will also be available to the public online at www.flowertrials.colostate.edu.

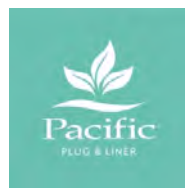

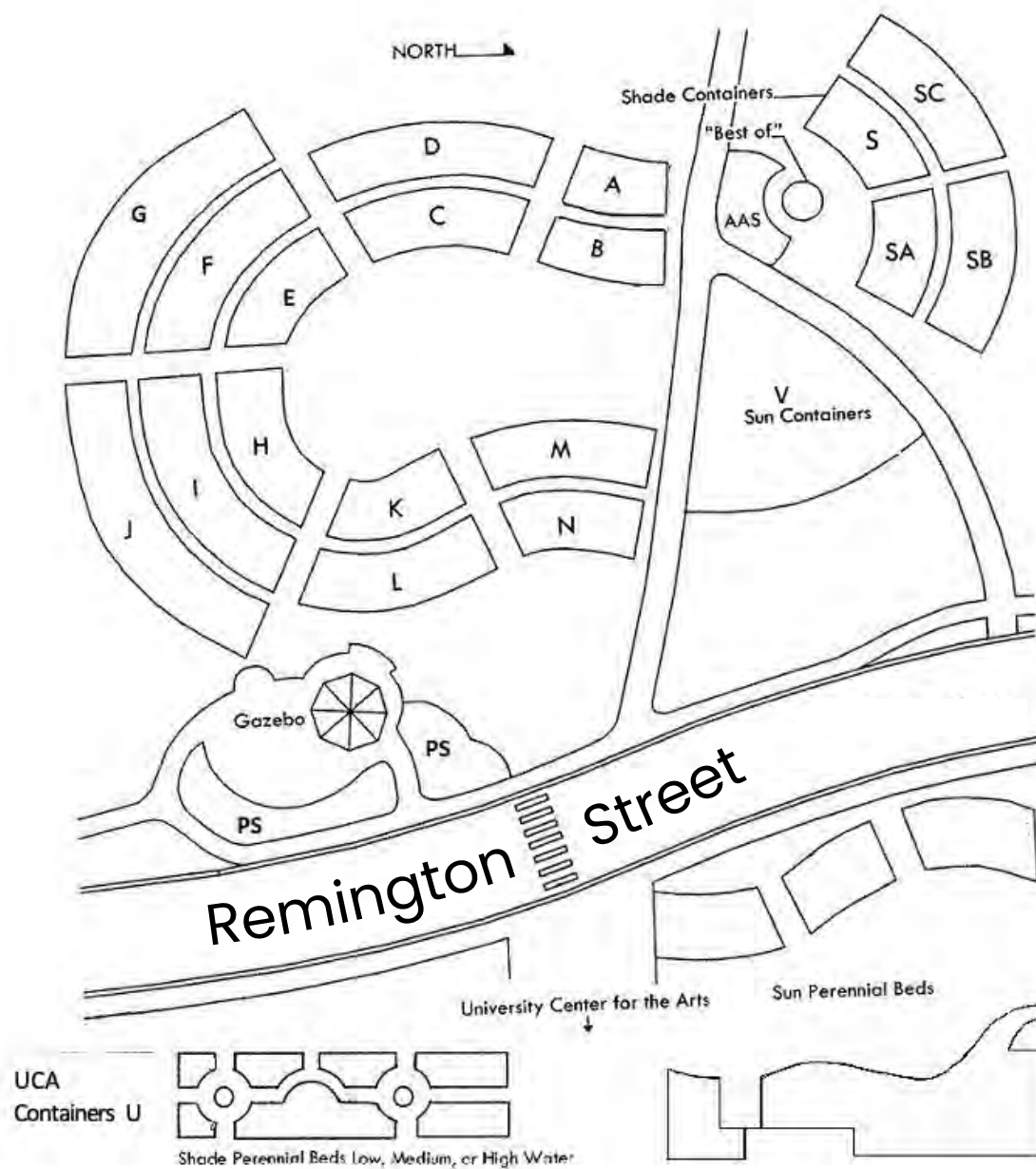

GREENHOUSE CULTURING

Grown at CSU Horticulture Center Greenhouses

Plant Entry Details

Seed Entries

- Seed delivered to CSU and then distributed to Blooma Farms and Kiyota Greenhouses delivered in January and February.
- All varieties of same genus grown at one location.
- Seed entries delivered to CSU Horticulture Center May 28 and 30.

Vegetative Entries

- Plugs and liners were received at CSU late March to mid-April.

Fertilization

- Fertigated: 200 ppm N of 14-4-14 (GreenCare and Harrell's brands)
- Applied using Dosatron® injector (7 gpm)
- Clear water on weekend or as needed.

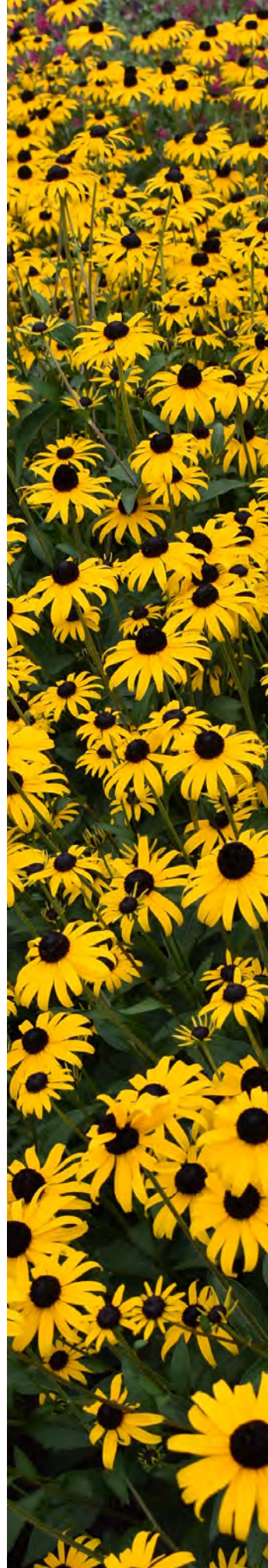
Chemical Treatments

- Banrot® Drench and Rootshield® applications to all plugs and liners upon arrival, before transplanting.
- Pageant® application (mites) May 3, 2024
- Mural® application (powdery mildew) April 11, 2024

GARDEN BEDS

Soil Preparation and Amendments

- Planting plots raked clean of old plant material and weeds
- Grower's Mix Media (Organix Supply, Inc.) was added to some planting plots to level planting plots.

Irrigation

- Immediately hand-watered after transplant.
- Planting beds watered between 1.0" and 1.5" per week.
- Planting beds typically watered between 2 and 3 times per week.
- Irrigation was adjusted reduced based on rain events or increased based on increased high temperatures.

Planting beds

- Top-dressed Pro-Rich 14-5-5 : 1 lb N per 1000 per sq. ft
- Osmocote® 14-4-14 : 6.4 g per sq. ft. (sun)

Post-plant

- Fertigated 200 ppm N using Harrell's 20-10-20, twice weekly (June)
- Fertigated 200 ppm N using Harrell's 14-4-14, twice weekly (July-September)

Planting Dates

Perennials were planted between May 20 and June 5, 2024.

Planting Methods

- Plants were trialed under **full sun** or **shade** conditions. Shade was provided from large broadleaf trees (~60–75% shading).
- Between 6 and 12 replications were planted. Replications varied based on plot space availability, plants supplied, species, and plot space.
- Plants were spaced on 12" centers, on average.

Garden Maintenance and Pest Management

Deadheading: All flowers deadheaded as needed to give a clean appearance and encourage secondary blooming.

In winter, dead plant material cut back to ground level.

Insect Control: Acelepryn® to roses and hollyhocks for Japanese Beetles July 11 and 19. Pylon was applied to primroses to control mites on July 19.

Disease Control: No major disease pressures in 2024 that required control measures.

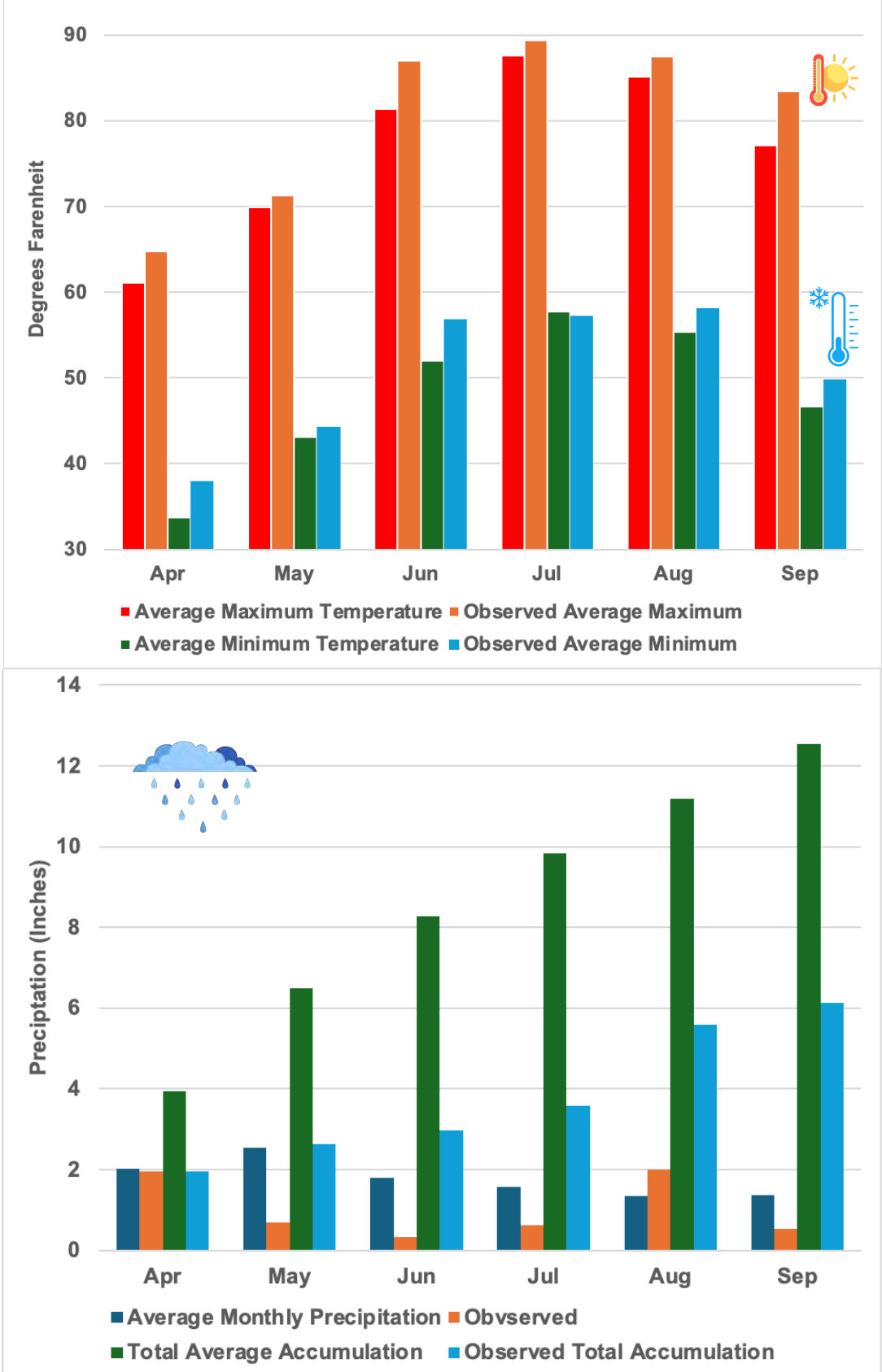
Weed Control: Hand weeding on a weekly basis. RoundUp® spot treatment as needed.

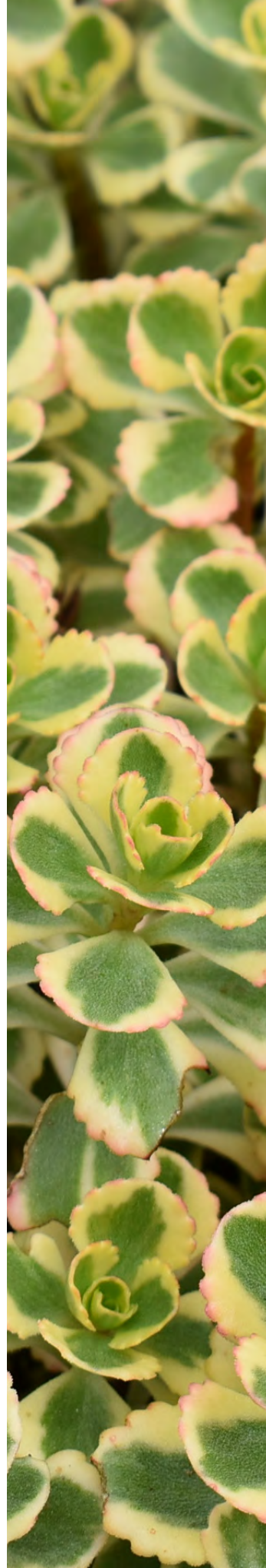
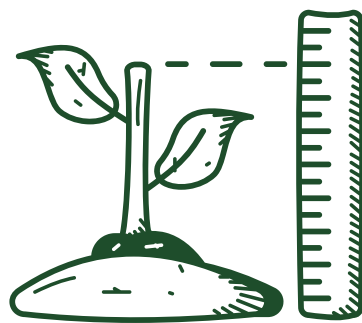
Data Collection and Methods

- A representative plant from trial plot was selected for data collection.
- For consistency--typically the third plant from front. If the third plant was not 'representative' (extremely smaller or larger, or dead), an alternative plant was selected for measurement.

Data Collections: Collected late in growing season (~September) to capture 'mature' plant size.

- **Plant Height:** measured from ground to tallest part of plant (including flowering stems).
- **Plant Width:** two measurements averaged from one measurement of widest and one perpendicular to the first measurement.

Photo Data Collected: Photo data are collected on a bi-weekly basis from ~mid-March to early October. Photos taken include plant plots, whole plants, and flower close-ups. Photos are labeled and available to view on the [CSU Trial Website](#).



PLANT EVALUATION

Plant Performance and Evaluation



- In addition to the data collection described above, plant performance and evaluations are conducted through the growing season (~June, July, August, and September). Rating scale below.
- Evaluators also provide additional comments and observations for entries for consideration.
- Evaluators include the student coordinator, trial garden director, research associate, along with members from the Perennial Trial subcommittee.

Plant Growth and Flowering rated using the following scale and criteria

Rating Scale	Plant Growth	Flowering
0 (Dead)	Dead	Dead
1 (Poor)	Plants very sick or dying	Extremely few flowers
2 (Below Average)	Plants unattractive in some form (i.e. – leggy growth habit, chlorotic or low vigor)	Flowers are few and sporadic
3 (Average)	Plant appearance with growth characteristics that would be expected for the time of season	Flowers would be few but <u>uniform</u> across the plants
4 (Good)	Plants look attractive (foliage, growth habit, etc.)	Flowers are blooming strong and showy
5 (Excellent)	Plants very healthy and uniform	Flowering is impressive

Plant Performance and Evaluation

- Additional plant ratings and evaluation parameters include:
 - **Plant form and quality** including *vigor, uniformity, foliage health, branching, sturdiness, etc.*
 - **Flowering** including *size, uniformity, flower presentation, flowering capacity, color stability, color balance in mixed plantings, etc.*
 - Other considerations including *fragrance (flowers or foliage), disease/pest damage, novelty, etc.*
- The above evaluation parameters factor into an **Overall Rating** (1 = very poor performance; 5 = excellent)

Top Performer Winners

“Top Performer” Selections

- Perennial Trial Subcommittee from the Trial Advisory Board met virtually on November 21, 2024.
- 72 entries were planted in 2022 and 23 were evaluated by the subcommittee. Data summaries and photos from the previous three growing seasons were evaluated. The committee then voted for top performing plants.
- Criteria defining a CSU ‘Top Performer’ includes significantly high survival percentages after two winters and three growing seasons (~80% or higher) and high average scores (~3.5 or higher) over the three growing seasons.
- Nine perennials were voted as a ‘Top Performer’ for 2024.

DELGENIUS™ 'CHANTAY' **DELPHINIUM** **(*DELPHINIUM* HYBRIDS)**

Pacific Plug and Liner



A staple in an English-style garden, delphiniums can be quite a showstopper for their impressive flowering stems. And Delgenius™ 'Chantay' doesn't disappoint! This robust, mid to late spring flowering perennial has flower power. Each plant produced sported several rich, robust lavender-dusty antique pink spikes with clean white centers. The plants sport deep green, dissect foliage for most of the season, leading to a second flush of flowering in early to mid-fall. Staking or providing support for the heavy flowering spikes is recommended!

'ORCHID FROST GRANDE' **LAMIUM** **(*LAMIUM MACULATUM*)**

Plant Haven

Looking for an excellent, adaptable ground cover? Check out this Plant Haven introduction. An improvement on Orchid Frost, 'Orchid Frost Grande' sports bigger, orchid-pink flowers, dancing above a nicely variegated green and white, almost silver-like foliage. Expect a solid flush of flowers in the spring, with spots of color for the rest of the season. The new foliage and growth cover the old flowers as the season progresses, making for a 'clean' looking appearance. This lamium works well as a solid ground cover, adapting to sun or shade, dry and more moist conditions. Also, a great option for integrating into mixed containers!

'EVENING SUN' MISSOURI EVENING PRIMROSE (*OENOTHERA MISSOURIENSIS*)

Darwin Perennials



Native—check. Pollinator—check. Drought tolerant—check. This low-growing (~6-8") hardy perennial also brings a pop of sunshine yellow color to the landscape! The bright yellow flowers open in the heat of the afternoon and last into the evening, attracting a variety of pollinators from bees to butterflies and moths, for weeks on end in the summer! The uniformly growing plants have attractive silver-green foliage, with few insect problems. AND, it's an easy to propagate plant for growers, that is also a reliable first-year flowering perennial.

'JELENA' RUSSIAN SAGE (*PEROVSKIA ATRIPLICIFOLIA*, SYN. *SALVIA YANGII*)

Dümmen Orange

Do you want a sturdy Russian sage for the garden? Then you should consider 'Jelena.' This selection has the typical lavender blue flowers, prolifically flowering from early summer and into the fall. This is a great landscape plant that is good candidate for a lower water input garden! In the CSU Gardens, it reached a very uniform ~36-48" tall, with no lodging! If grown drier, one could expect it to be closer to ~18-24". It is a pollinator magnet plant, with a beautiful gray-green dissect foliage.

'GOLDEN FEATHERS' JACOB'S LADDER (*POLEMONIUM PULCHERRIMUM*)

Darwin Perennials



Polemonium for the full sun? Look no further... 'Golden Feathers' Jacob's ladder can tolerate more sun than the other Polemonium! This golden yellow variegated variety can pack a real punch, even on ~8" tall plants! The warm glow of the foliage, contrasts with the soft lavender-blue flowers in late spring to early summer—a bee favorite. Here in Colorado, with the high light intensities, the best plant performance and yellow foliage coloration will be in partial sun (morning) with afternoon open or filtered shade. 'Golden Feathers' can also be reliably propped through tissue culture.

'GOLDBLITZ' BLACK-EYED SUSAN (*RUDBECKIA FULGIDA* VAR. *SULLIVANTII*)

Kieft Seed

If you're wanting an alternative to 'Goldsturm', give 'Goldblitz' a try! This seed grown Rudbeckia can be a first-year flowering plant, with a slightly shorter production time and slightly earlier flowering—a real benefit in the retail garden centers. In our trials, it was an earlier flowering Rudbeckia, with very uniform and consistent performance over the three-year period. The 24-30" plants with golden ray florets and a rich deep brown cone, showed great vigor, with dark green foliage all the way to the end of the season. Another great plant for pollinators in the landscape.

'CONGA LINE' STONECROP **(*HYLOTELEPHIUM*** ***TELEPHIUM*)**

Terra Nova® Nurseries



You will want to invite this one to your dance party! 'Conga Line' has a beautiful deep green foliage that gradually matures into a deep purple green, later in the summer. By mid-summer, the red-purple colored flower bud clusters are developing, ultimately opening into an eye-catching peachy-cream dallops of color on top of upright branches. Even in our trials with more consistent irrigation, the stems were strong and upright. Like most of our sedum faves, this one also is a waterwise plant, handling lower water inputs and great pollinator plant to boot! Oh...and it handles the cold—hardy from zones 4 to 9!

'PRISTINE® PRINCESS PINK' **BEARDTONGUE** **(*PENSTEMON BARBATUS* VAR. *PRAECOX*)**

Dümmen Orange



Add a splash of bubblegum pink to the garden! Uniform plants boasted dozens of sturdy spikes, covered with tubular flowers in mid-summer. The crisp, glossy green foliage accented the pink flowers on ~24" stems in our trials. 'Pristine® Princess Pink' was a hummingbird and pollinator favorite! Ideally, good draining soil will help with plant survivability, especially in the winter. This is a great xeric plant once established!

**'SKYWARDTM BLUE' AND
'SKYWARDTM PINK'
SPEEDWELL
(*VERONICA LONGIFOLIA*)**
Darwin Perennials

Aptly named, with dozens of spires of rich violet-blue and vibrant pink, pointing to the stars. Both 'SkywardTM Blue' and 'SkywardTM Pink' are well matched in this series. Copious amounts of spikes begin in late spring, shooting off like early fireworks in the gardens and with intermittent shows all the way into fall, with simple deadheading. The dark green, lush foliage is more resistant to powdery mildew, than 'Moody Blues.' Either of these speedwells would be a great addition to the perennial border!
